TRIMIT INVENTORY PROFILE 24.1

This document contains information about the Inventory Profile (Availability) functionality in TRIMIT 24.1 for Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central 2024, Wave 1 (W1).

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INTRODUCTION

The **TRIMIT Inventory Profile** gives the user a simple, flexible, and dynamic tool to get Inventory and Availability information.

In comparison to standard Business Central Availability per Item per Event, Period, Location, (BC) Variant, BOM Level and Timeline, the **TRIMIT Inventory Profile** can show all these different views – besides the Timeline – overseen via one page.

It is also able to show the information on Item Level, as well as on X-Axis (for Fashion this could be Color) level for all the different values on the Y-Axis (for Fashion this could be the Sizes).

Keep in mind however, that standard Business Central Availability does NOT show the decreases and increases related to TRIMIT Production – we created Inventory Profile for it!

The Inventory Profile can be shown as:

- Inventory Profile (for an Item)
- Inventory Profile Components (for underlying Components based on a Bill of Materials)
- Matrix Inventory Profile (for a Master + Variant)

The audience for this document is the Consultant or very skilled User.

It will only describe the TRIMIT fields/functionality and not the standard Business Central fields/functionality.

Be aware of not changing settings and parameters in a live database without consulting the implementing partner.

The functionality described is the functionality as of **TRIMIT 24.1 for Business Central W1 BC24.X**.

The pictures in this White Paper are based on the demo database for **TRIMIT 24.1**, which is based on Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central 2024 Release Wave 1, in the demo company **CRONUS TRIMIT W1 Ltd.** (based on CRONUS International Ltd. of Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central).

WHERE TO FIND INVENTORY PROFILE

The **TRIMIT Inventory Profile** can be opened from:

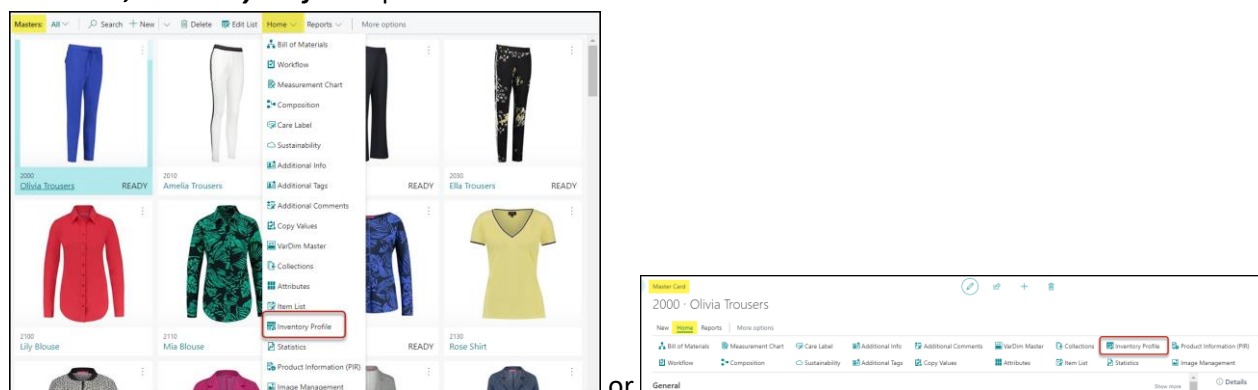
- Master List/Card
- Item List/Card
- Sales Document Line (like Quote, Order, Blanket Order, Return Order, Invoice, Credit Memo)
- Purchase Document Line (like Quote, Order, Blanket Order, Return Order, Invoice, Credit Memo)
- TRIMIT Production Order List/Card
- TRIMIT Production Collecting Order Line
- Via the Matrix of Sales, Purchase, Production Collecting Order and Complaint
- More (almost any place, where an Item number is used)

The Inventory Profile will always open in a way that fits the Item as the **Inventory Profile**, the **Inventory Profile Components**, or the **Matrix Inventory Profile**.

The following describes how to open the Inventory Profile from various places in the system.

MASTER LIST / CARD

Via **Home, Inventory Profile** or press **Shift+Ctrl+F9**

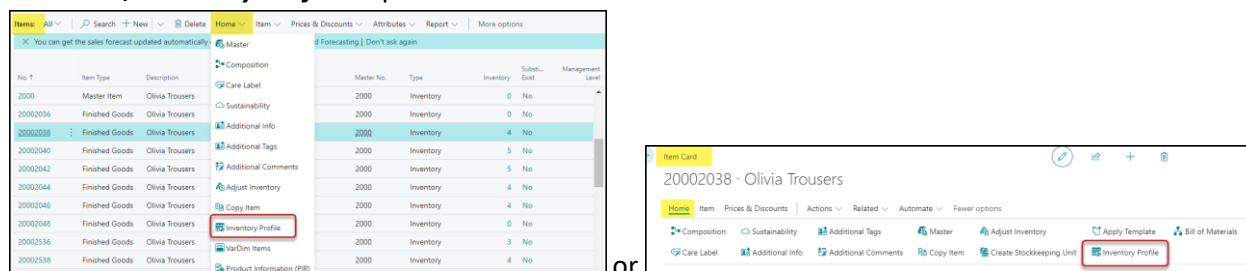


This will open the **Matrix Inventory Profile** for all the Y-Axis (in Fashion that might be Color) of the Master. It is therefore only applicable for Masters with a Matrix.

If the Master also has an Assortment Matrix, you will also see the Y-Axis for the Assortments separately.

ITEM LIST / CARD

Via **Home, Inventory Profile** or press **Shift+Ctrl+F9**



This will open the (Item) Inventory Profile for this specific Item.

It can however give you an error message if the Item number is the same as the Master number, and the Master does not have Variants.

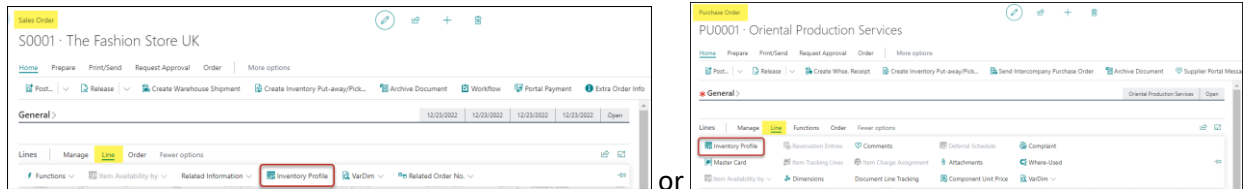
SALES (OR PURCHASE) DOCUMENT LINE

The **Inventory Profile** can be opened in four ways:

- On the Line Action Bar: Via **Line, Inventory Profile** or press **Shift+Ctrl+F9**.

If done on a *Matrix* Line or *Assortment Matrix* Line, it will open the **Matrix Inventory Profile**.

If done on an *Item* Line, it will open the **Inventory Profile**.

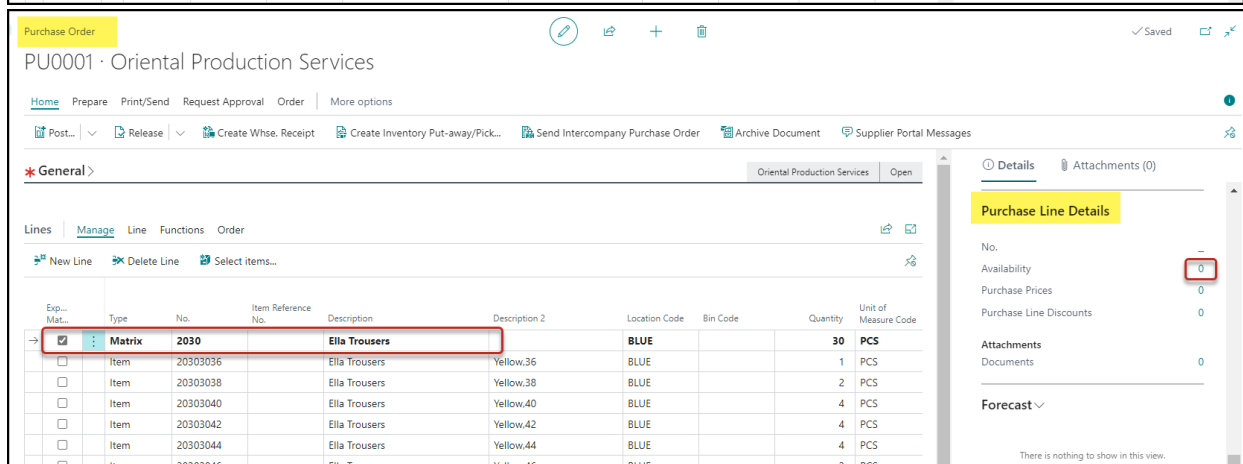
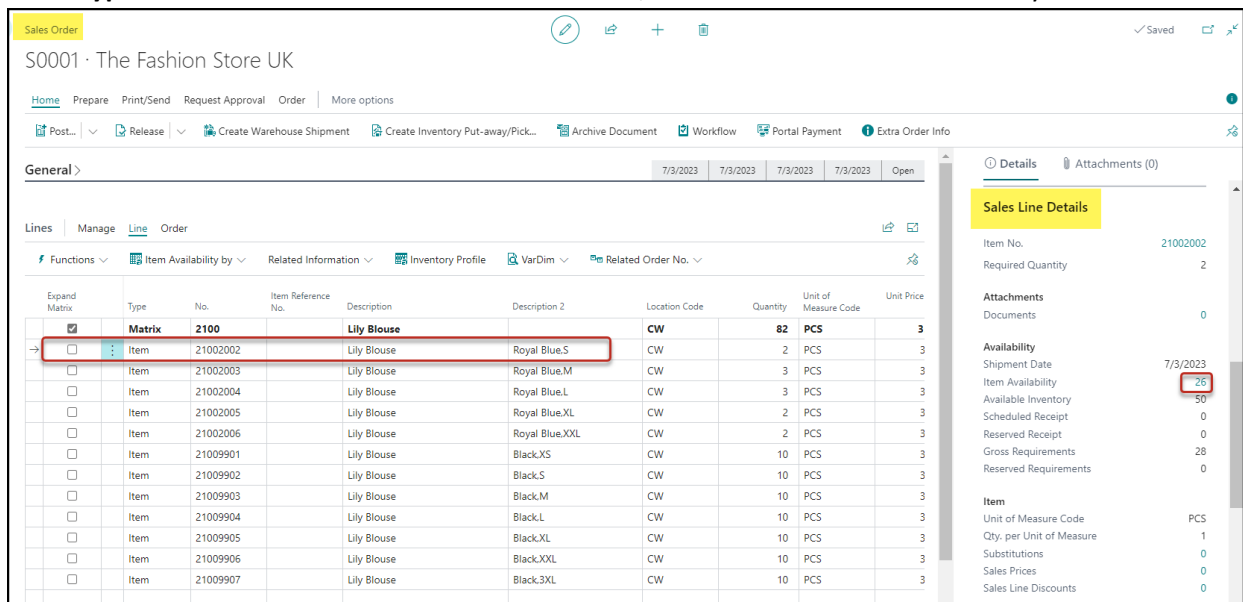


Depending on the **Type** of the Line, it will show the Matrix related Sizes (if **Type** is *Matrix*) or the Assortment Matrix related Sizes (if **Type** is *Assortment Matrix*).

- Via the FactBox **Sales Line Details** or **Purchase Line Details** (you might have to add it in the page yourself), click on the Quantity behind (**Item**) **Availability**.

If the **Type** of the Line is *Item*, it will show the Inventory Profile for that specific Item.

If the **Type** of the Line is *Matrix* or *Assortment Matrix*, it will show the Matrix Inventory Profile



Although the **Availability** is showing 0 (zero), when standing on a Line with **Type Matrix** or **Assortment Matrix**, there might be Items of this Master that do have Availability.

- In a Matrix, you can click **Matrix Inventory Profile** (or press **F7**) to open the **Matrix Inventory Profile** of the Y-Axis you are standing on.

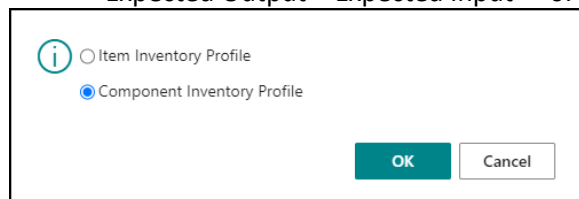

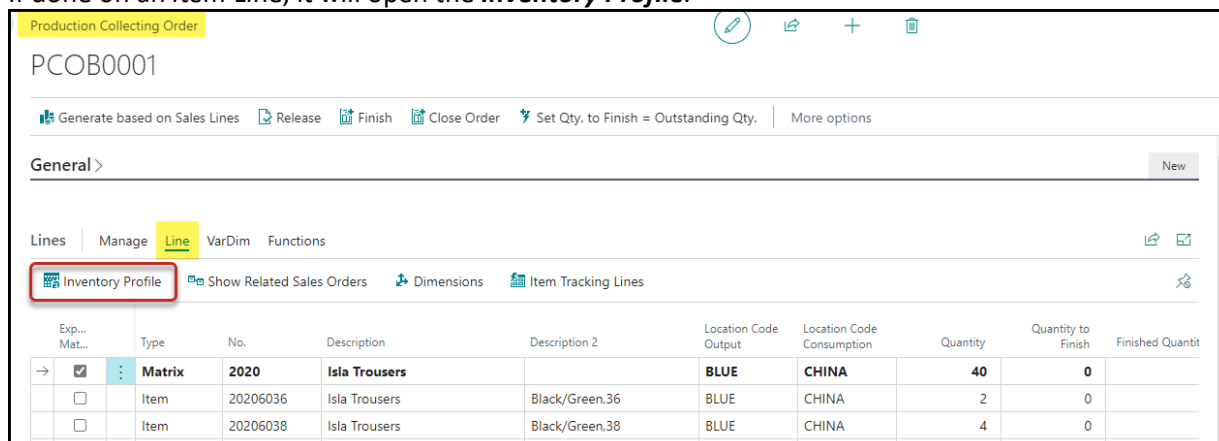
The **Item Inventory Profile** is the normal Inventory Profile for the Item of the Production Order Line.

The **Component Inventory Profile** is based on the Components of the Bill of Materials that are needed for this specific Component Line (so from a lower level in your BOM structure).

TRIMIT PRODUCTION COLLECTING ORDER LINE

The **Inventory Profile** can be opened in three ways:

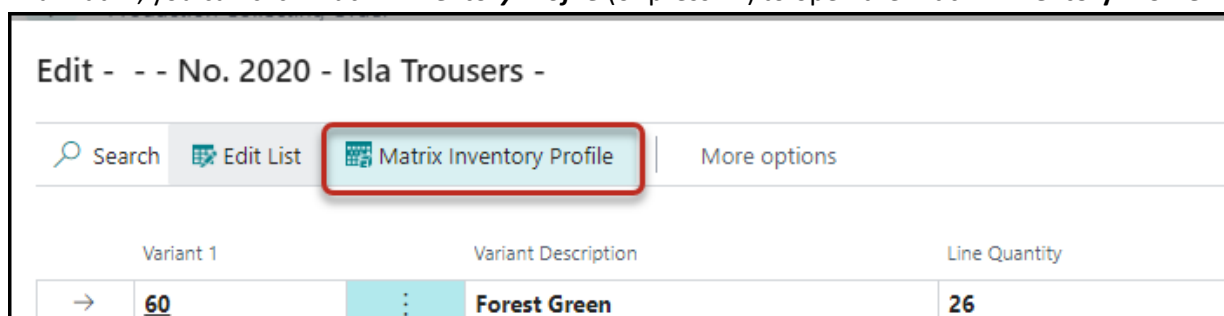
- On the Line Action Bar: Click **Line, Inventory Profile** or press **Shift+ Ctrl+F9**
If done on a *Matrix Line* or an *Assortment Matrix Line*, it will open the **Matrix Inventory Profile**.
If done on an *Item Line*, it will open the **Inventory Profile**.

NOTE

The content of the **Inventory Profile** will look different for the Matrix options:

The **Matrix Inventory Profile** page for a specific Master will show the Document Types in the Lines and Quantities for the Sizes on the columns.

Enter "i" in a cell will open the **Inventory Profile** page for a specific Item in which the Dates will be shown in the Lines and the Quantities per Document Type in the columns.

Which Document Types are shown (and included in the Quantities) depends on the [Inventory Profile Setup](#) that will be discussed later in this White Paper

SETUPS

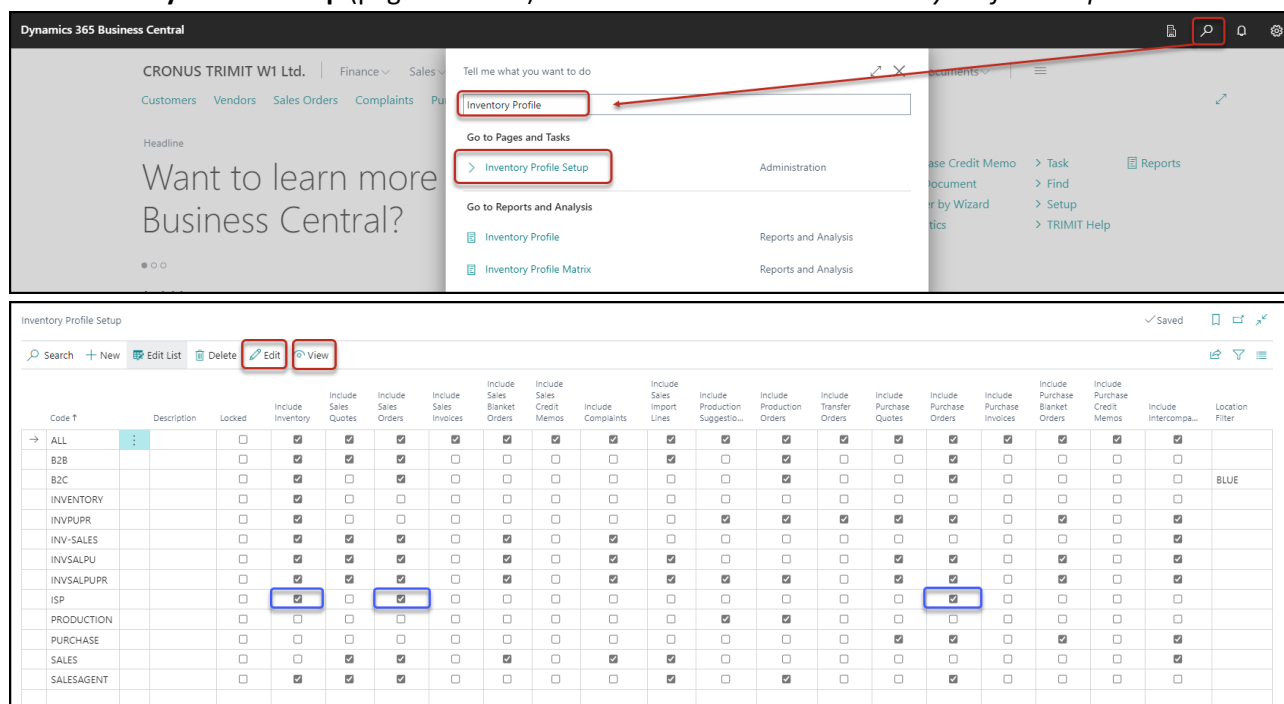
This section describes where to find the setups that influence the **Inventory Profile** and therefore needs to be setup before using the Inventory Profile.

INVENTORY PROFILE SETUP

The purpose of the **Inventory Profile Setup** is to show only relevant information (Document Types) for the user. Keep in mind however, that the **Expected Inventory** and **Available Quantity** will only be calculated from the selected Document Types, even if there are other expected increases and decreases.

The **Inventory Profile** can display 16 different columns (Document Types) of information of an Item. However, not all columns are relevant for every user. I.e., a salesperson is only interested in seeing what can be sold; hence, information like **Production Suggestions**, **Purchase Quotes** etc. are not relevant for the salesperson, as they may not be realized.

The **Inventory Profile Setup** (page 6036521) can be found via **Search Inventory Profile Setup**.

FASTTAB GENERAL

CODE

The code for this **Inventory Profile Setup**.

DESCRIPTION

You can enter a **Description** for this **Inventory Profile Setup**

LOCKED

If you put a checkmark in **Locked**, you are not able to change the settings of the **Inventory Profile Setup**. You will get an error message.

Removing the checkmark, will open the possibility again to modify the content of the Setup.

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FASTTAB SETTING

You can decide which quantities you want to include in the Inventory Profile to determine the (expected) Availability. Most of the fields speak for itself.

INCLUDE SALES IMPORT LINES

A checkmark in this field will include the imported Sales Lines, which are not yet 'posted' to become regular Sales Order Lines.

This can be based on Portals, Webshops or by importing Sales Lines by using API.

INCLUDE INTERCOMPANY ORDERS

If you had a checkmark in **Include Sales Orders** and a checkmark in **Include Intercompany Orders**, then also the Intercompany Sales Orders will be included.

If you had a checkmark in **Include Purchase Orders** and a checkmark in **Include Intercompany Orders**, then also the Intercompany Purchase Orders will be included.

FASTTAB MISC. PARAMETERS

INCLUDE EXCLUDED LINES

A checkmark in this field means that Sales-/Purchase/Complaint Lines of Orders with a checkmark in field **Exclude Availability Check** on FastTab **Misc. Parameters** will be included in the Sales/Purchase/Complaint Quantities.

INCLUDE EXCLUDED BINS

A checkmark in this field means that Bin Content of Bins with a check in field **Exclude Availability Check** will be included in the Inventory quantity.

NOTE

The field **Exclude Availability Check** in the Bins of a Location is not in the list of the Bins; you need to add it to the page if you want to set this field.

AVAIL. CHECK UNDERLYING LEVEL WITHOUT REL. ORDER

When we run an Availability Check on Components, we usually require that a Related Order has been created – which is the right way – as this will 'reserve' the Components on the fly.

However, especially regarding the Webshops, users want to have an Availability Check based on the Components, without having the Related Order created. Therefore, it will use the Bill of Materials.

This field allows to do so – however note that in this case, it is only a truth as generated – as the Components are NOT reserved and can be used just a split second after.

Also, there can be scenarios where two users are doing an Availability Check at the same time using the same Components, and both gets confirmed that it is available. The unsafety by using this, is why you deliberately must set a Checkmark in this field, if you want to live with the above-mentioned consequences.

FASTTAB FILTERS

HORIZON AVAILABILITY CHECK

In this field, you can enter a Date Formula that will be used to calculate the End Date of the Availability Check. If you for instance only want to check the Availability situation for the next six months, you can enter the Date Formula *6M*.

If you do not fill this field, the Horizon Date will be set based on the **Horizon Availability Check** in the Inventory Setup.

NOTE

The Date Formula should at least be as long as the longest delivery period for your Items or you can keep it empty; in that case, it will be calculated based on the **Horizon Availability Check** in the Inventory Setup. If also that parameter is empty, all the demands and expected receipts will be considered.

IMPORT DOCUMENT TYPE FILTER

This field is not by default visible in the page; you need to add it via **Personalize**.

This field is only applicable if you do have a checkmark in **Include Sales Import Lines**.

Sales Import Lines can be based on the TRIMIT Portals, Integration Setup (API) or Consignation.

If the **Import Document Type Filter** is not filled, you will only include Portal Sales Quotes/Orders of one of the TRIMIT Portals that have not been 'posted' yet to the regular Sales Orders – so they are still in the **Portal Sales Documents**.

Possible values for the **Import Document Type** are *Consignment (0)*, *CPO (1)* and *Integration (3)*.

So the **Import Document Type Filter** could i.e., be filled with *Integration* or *3* if you only want to include the Sales Documents of an Integration Setup, that have not been 'posted' yet to the regular Sales Orders – so they are still in the **Integration Sales Documents**.

LOCATION FILTER

In this field, you can enter a specific Location Filter, so only the Inventory, increases and decreases in those Locations will be considered.

FASTTAB MATRIX INVENTORY PROFILE DEFAULTS

TRANSACTION TYPE DEFAULT

If you open the **Matrix Inventory Profile** page, the **Show Transaction Type** will be set by default based on this field in the chosen Inventory Profile Setup.

This field will determine what you will see by default on the Lines.

It can be changed in the **Matrix Inventory Profile** page.

You can choose between the following two options:

Transaction	On the Lines of the Matrix Inventory Profile, you will see the document types (like Sales Order, Purchase Order, Production Decrease, etc.)
Date	On the Lines of the Matrix Inventory Profile, you will see the different Dates of the documents (like Shipment Dates, Expected Receipt Dates, End Dates, etc.)

CALCULATE ASSORTMENT DEFAULT

If you open the **Matrix Inventory Profile** page, the **Calculate Assortment** will be set by default based on this field in the chosen Inventory Profile Setup. This field will determine what you will see regarding Assortments. It can be changed in the **Matrix Inventory Profile** page.

You can choose between the following three options:

Quantity	This will simply show the quantities of the Assortments itself.
Pieces	This will show the quantity of pieces within the Assortments itself. I.e., an Assortment has 1S, 2M, 2L, 1XL; then if 1 Assortment is available, it will show 6 instead of 1 – as it would show if you chose the option <i>Quantity</i>
Split Assortment	This will not show the quantities of the Assortments but will split the Assortment into the individual Sizes. I.e., an Assortment has 1S, 2M, 2L, 1XL; then if 1 Assortment is available, it will show these quantities under the regular Sizes S, M, L and XL.

LIMIT HORIZON DEFAULT=YES

If you open the **Matrix Inventory Profile** page, the field **Limit Horizon** will be set by default based on this field in the chosen Inventory Profile Setup.

This field determines if you want to limit the Transactions (when **Show Transaction Type** is *Transaction*) based on the **Horizon Availability Check** that the system determines.

If you do not enter a checkmark, the **Matrix Inventory Profile** will simply show all existing Transactions.

SHOW SUB-TOTALS

This field determines for the **Matrix Inventory Profile** if you want to see the Sub-Totals for **Expected Output, Available I and Expected Input**

In this Parameter, you can enter a Date Formula that will be used to calculate the End Date of the Availability Check. If you for instance only want to check the Availability situation for the next six months, you can enter the Date Formula **6M**.

If you do not fill in this Parameter, the Horizon Date will be set to the Date of the last Transaction of the current Item.

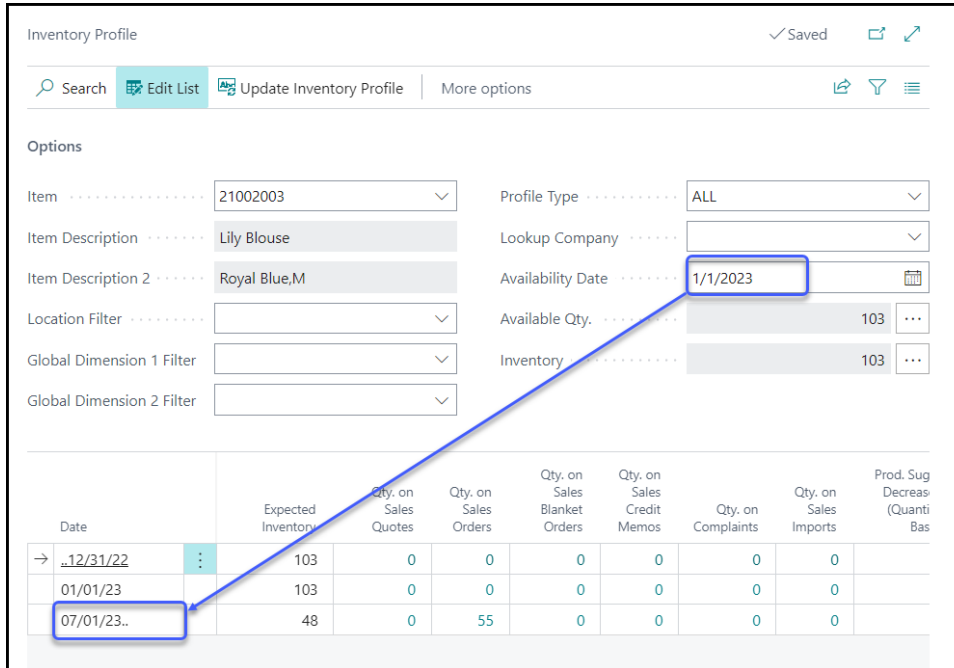

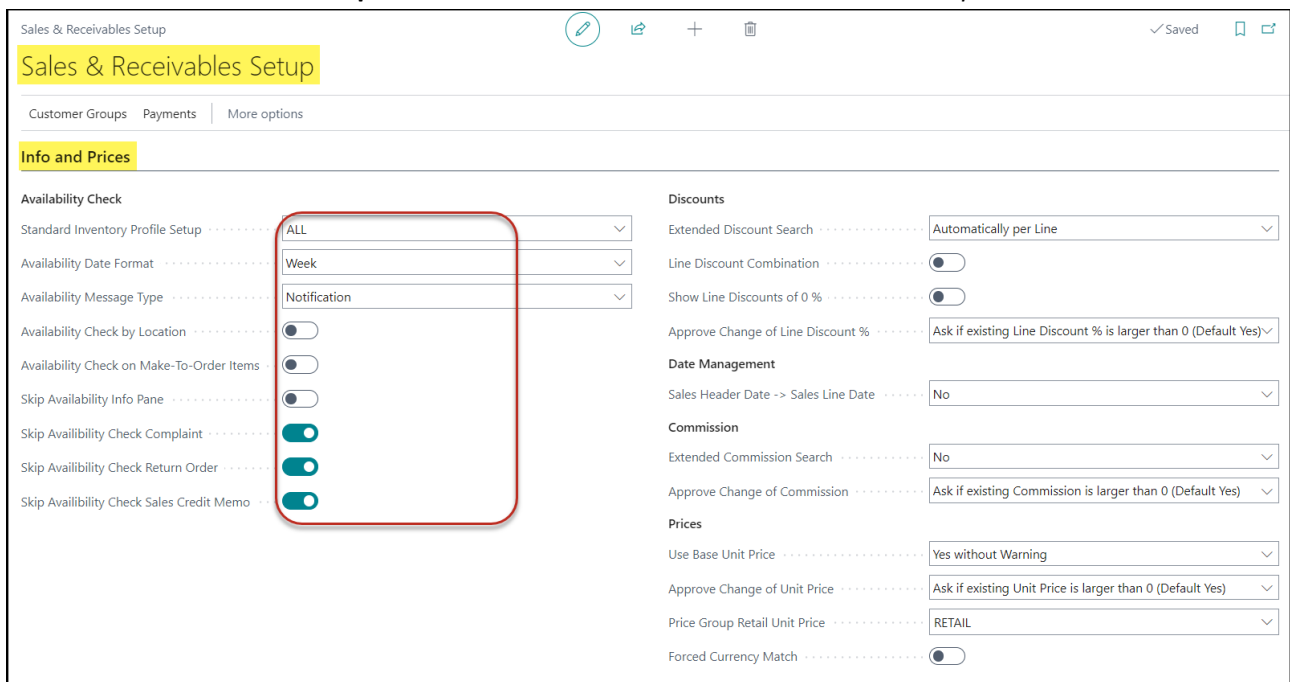


In addition, even in the **Order Type** the **Horizon Availability Check** can be set, but there it is a hard Date and not a Date Formula. SALES & RECEIVABLES SETUP

The **Sales & Receivables Setup** can be found via **Search Sales & Receivables Setup**



STANDARD INVENTORY PROFILE SETUP

This Parameter determines which documents (Sales, Purchase and Production) will be default included in the Inventory Profile based on an **Inventory Profile Setup**.

If you leave this Parameter blank, all document types will be included.

AVAILABILITY DATE FORMAT

This Parameter determines whether the TRIMIT Availability Check is done in Days or Weeks.

AVAILABILITY MESSAGE TYPE

You can determine how a message regarding availability should be shown in a Sales Order.

You can choose between the following two options:

Notification	The message will be shown as a notification, and you do not have to confirm anything; you can simply continue with entering data.
Message	The message will be shown as a message, and you need to confirm the message before you can continue.

AVAILABILITY CHECK BY LOCATION

If you want TRIMIT Availability Check by Location, you must set this Parameter to *Yes*.

This Parameter must be set to *Yes*, if you want to use the full WMS functionality, and therefore will set the **Use Warehouse Functionality** in the Inventory Setup to *Yes*.

AVAILABILITY CHECK ON MAKE-TO-ORDER ITEMS

If you also want the TRIMIT Availability Check to calculate the Availability for Items with **Replenishment System Order**, you must set this Parameter to *Yes*.

Because Items with **Replenishment System Order**, will get Related Orders (perhaps immediately when entering the quantities on a Sales Line or via an MRP), it simply saves time to not check Availability for these Items, and it will not consider available Quantity on Inventory for a Related Order.

Therefore, if you do have some Inventory for your Items with **Replenishment System Order**, it will simply neglect them, and the Related Order will always get the same Quantity as the Sales Line itself if this Parameter is set to *No*.

SKIP AVAILABILITY INFO PANE

This Parameter determines if the system should automatically calculate the Availability in the **Sales Line Details** FactBox of a Sales Line.

If you choose *Yes*, the Availability will not be calculated, and this might be important regarding performance in the Sales Order entry.

If you choose *No*, the Availability will be calculated the moment you enter the Items on the Sales Lines.

SKIP AVAILABILITY CHECK COMPLAINT

This Parameter determines if an availability check should take place when entering a Line in a Complaint.

If you choose *Yes*, the Availability will not be calculated.

If you choose *No*, the Availability will be calculated, and you can get messages.

SKIP AVAILABILITY CHECK RETURN ORDER

This Parameter determines if an availability check should take place when entering a Line in a Sales Return Order.

If you choose *Yes*, the Availability will not be calculated.

If you choose *No*, the Availability will be calculated, and you can get messages.

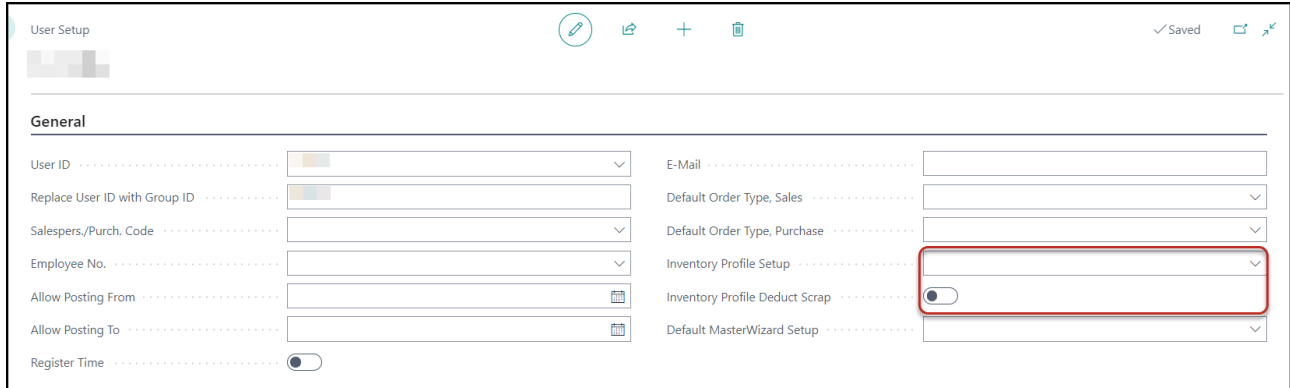

USER SETUP

The **Standard Inventory Profile Setup** in the **Sales & Receivables Setup** can also be overruled per User via **Search User Setup**



INVENTORY PROFILE SETUP

This Parameter is the default **Inventory Profile Setup** when you look at the Inventory Profile (or Availability Overview) of Masters or in Sales-/Purchase-/Production Orders.

It determines what information you will see.

It will overrule the **Standard Inventory Profile Setup** in the **Sales & Receivables Setup** and the **Inventory Profile Setup** in an Order Type.

INVENTORY PROFILE DEDUCT SCRAP

If in the Master/Item Card, you entered a Scrap %: do you want to see the demand for this Master/Item including the Scrap % or without the Scrap % in the Inventory Profile.

A checkmark in **Inventory Profile Deduct Scrap** means that this User ID does not want to see the demand including the Scrap %.

MASTER / ITEM

Via clicking **Masters** or **Product Design, Masters** in a TRIMIT Role Center or via **Search Masters**.

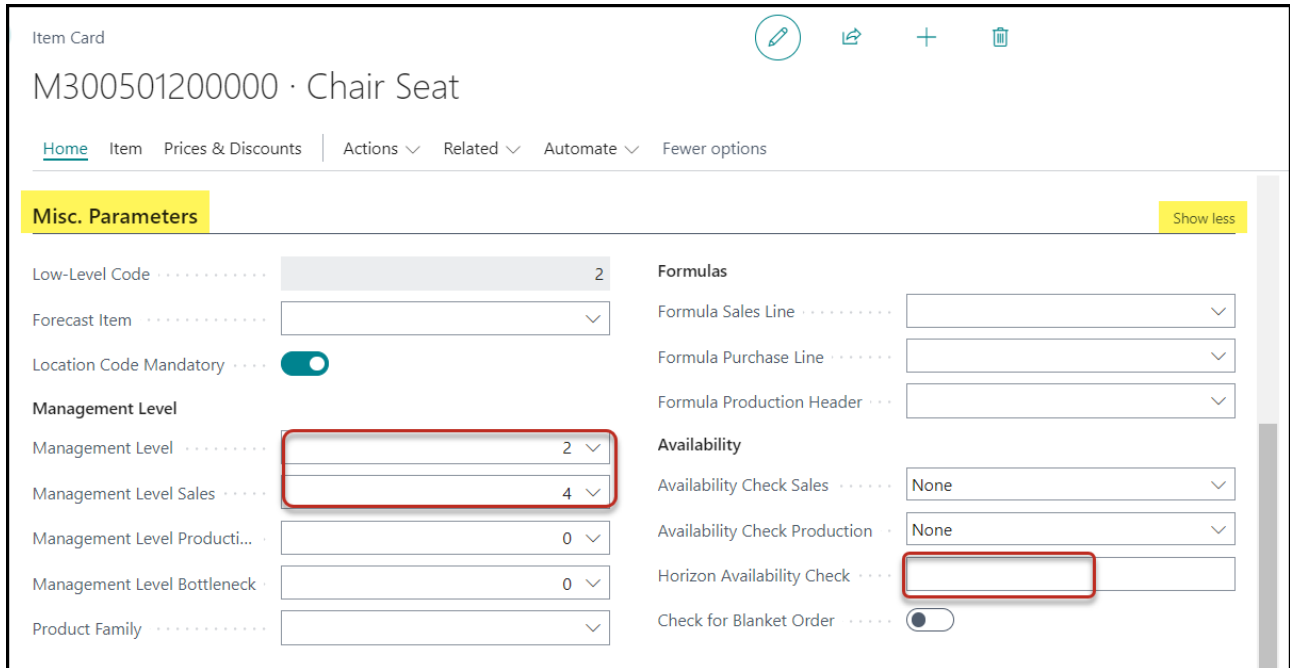

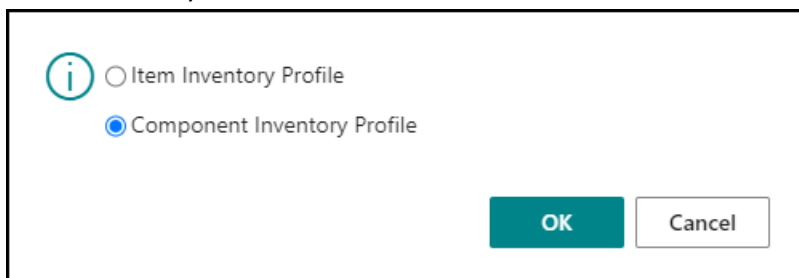


MANAGEMENT LEVELS

For Masters with Bill of Materials (BOM) one or more Components in the BOM can decide the available Quantity for the Items, and therefore the look-and-feel of the Inventory Profile as well.

This is setup in the fields **Management Level** and **Management Level Sales** on the Master – which can also be changed per Item.

When an Item has a **Management Level** < **Management Level Sales** the **Components Inventory Profile** will open. However, if there are Transactions on the Item, the system will automatically ask the user to select which Inventory Profile should be shown:



HORIZON AVAILABILITY CHECK

The content of this field in the Master will overrule the parameter of the **Inventory Setup**.

The content of this field in the Item will overrule the parameter in the **Inventory Setup** and in the **Master**.

But in Sales-/Purchase Orders with an **Order Type** the **Horizon Availability Check** Date of the Order Type will overrule the setting of the Master or Item.

INVENTORY PROFILE SETUP

If you open the Inventory Profile via a Sales-/Purchase Document with this specific **Order Type**, the **Profile Type** will by default be filled with the content of this **Inventory Profile Type** and not with the **Standard Inventory Profile Type** of the Inventory Setup unless you have entered an **Inventory Profile Setup** in the User ID.

HORIZON AVAILABILITY CHECK

In this field, you can enter a Date – so not a Date Formula as in the **Inventory Setup, Master, or Item**.

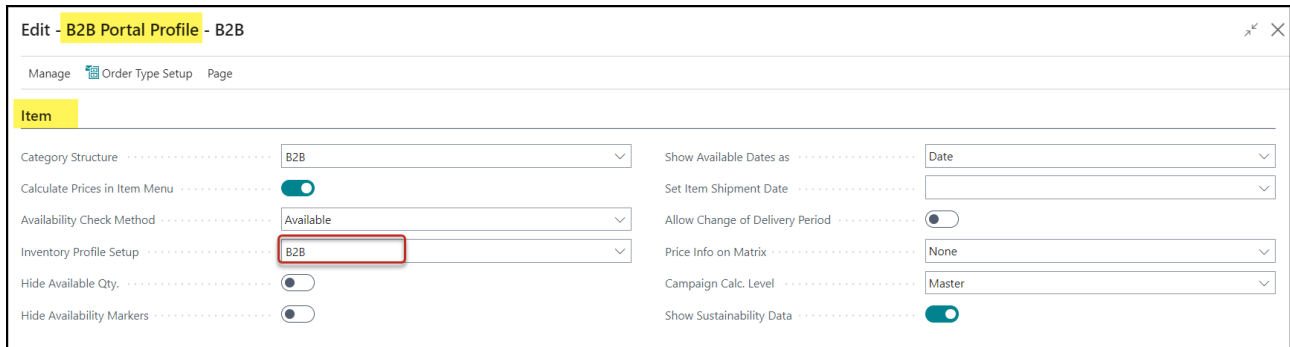
If you ask for the **Inventory Profile** via a Sales Document or Purchase Document with this specific **Order Type**, the horizon for the Inventory Profile – the last Date Line – will be based on this field and therefore overrule the **Horizon Availability Check** in the **Inventory Setup, Master, or Item**.

PORTAL PROFILES

Also, in the **Portal Profiles**, you can enter a specific **Inventory Profile Setup**.

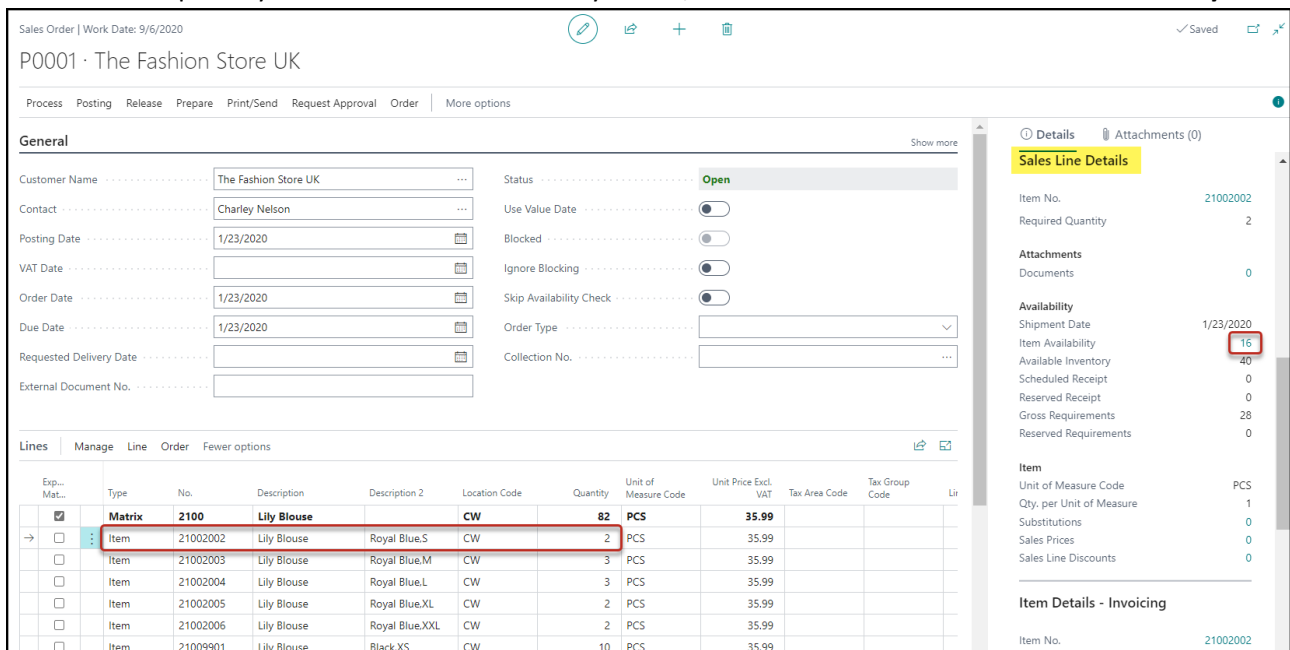

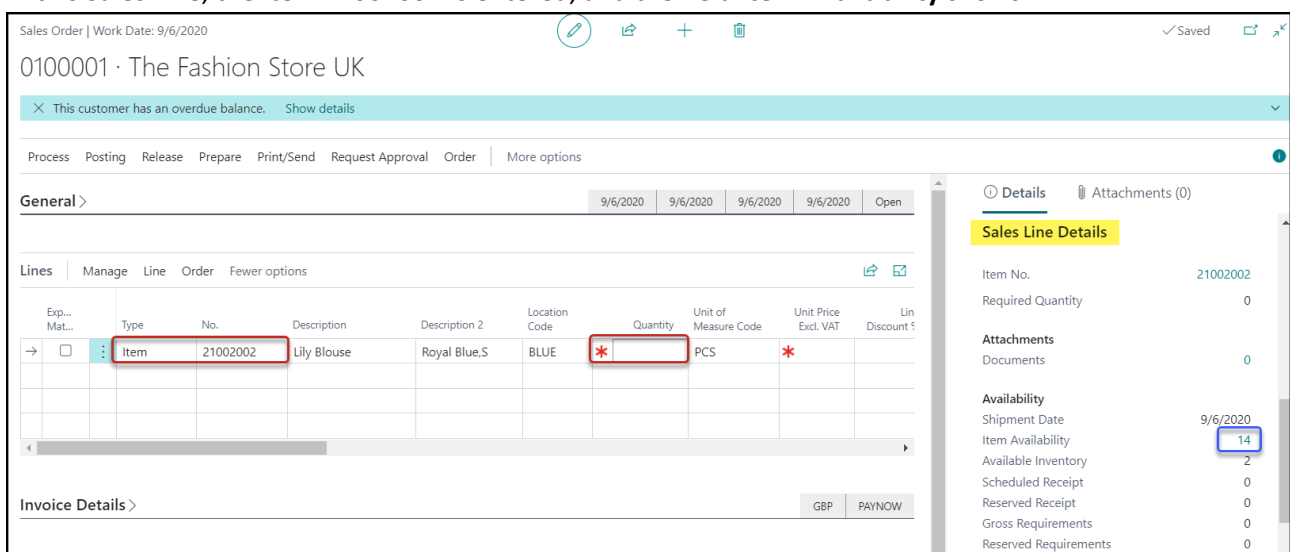

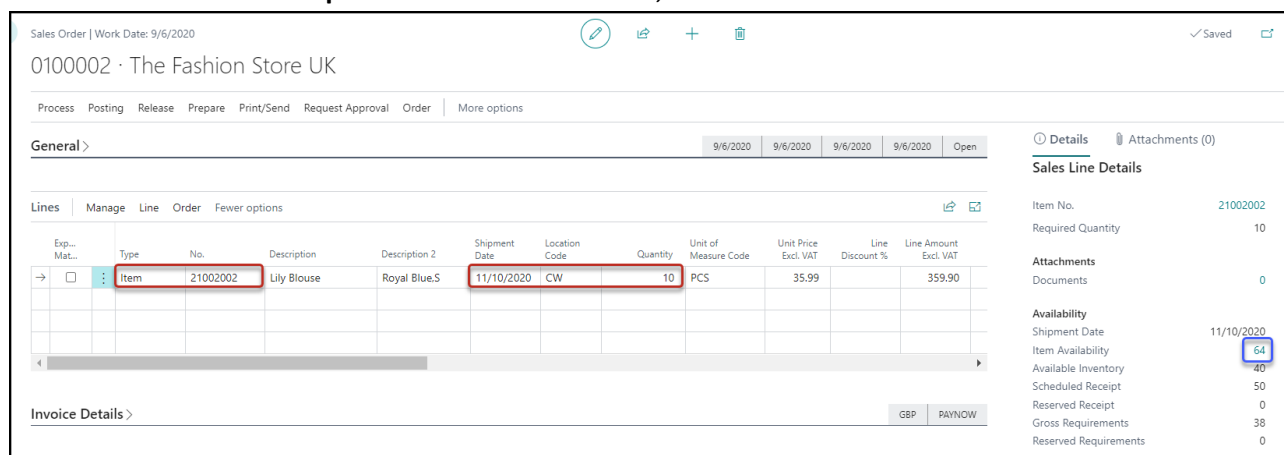
INVENTORY PROFILE

In the **Inventory Profile** for an Item, both **Available Quantity** and **Inventory** is shown. These two values are not the same. The **Inventory** is units of an Item that are on stock. The **Available Quantity** is a calculation, where both the Inventory level and all types of Orders (Sales, Purchase, Production, Complaint, Transfer, etc.) are summarized.

EXAMPLE 2:

An extra Purchase Order has been added for **Item 21002002** of **50 Pieces** with an **Expected Receipt Date of November 7, 2020**, and the Sales Lines of **Example 1** have been deleted again.

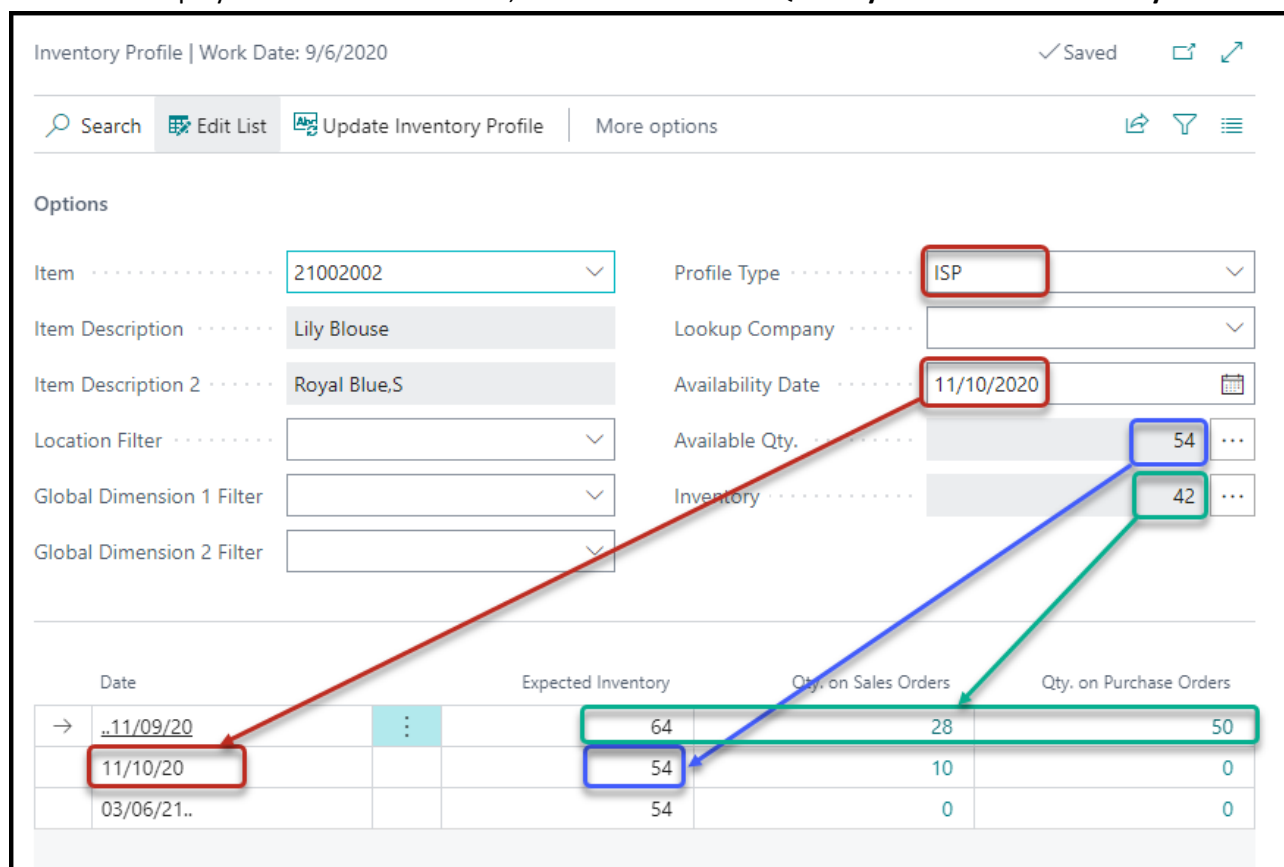

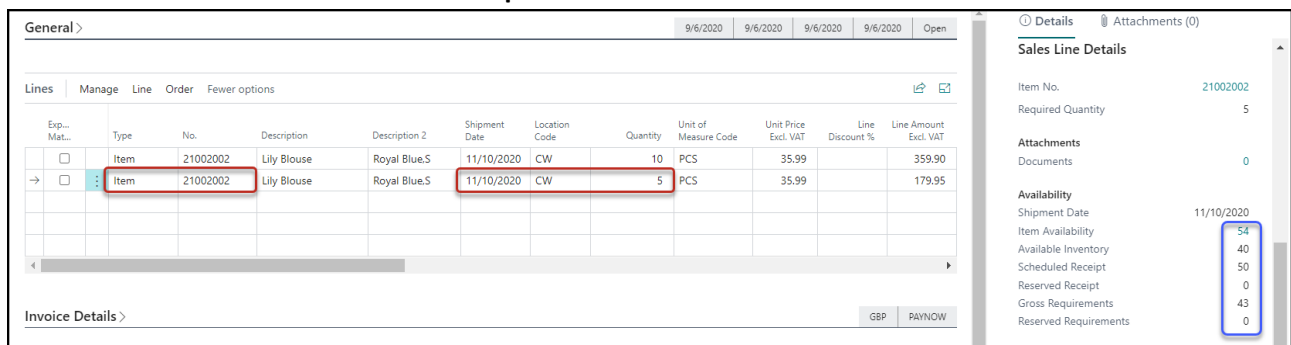

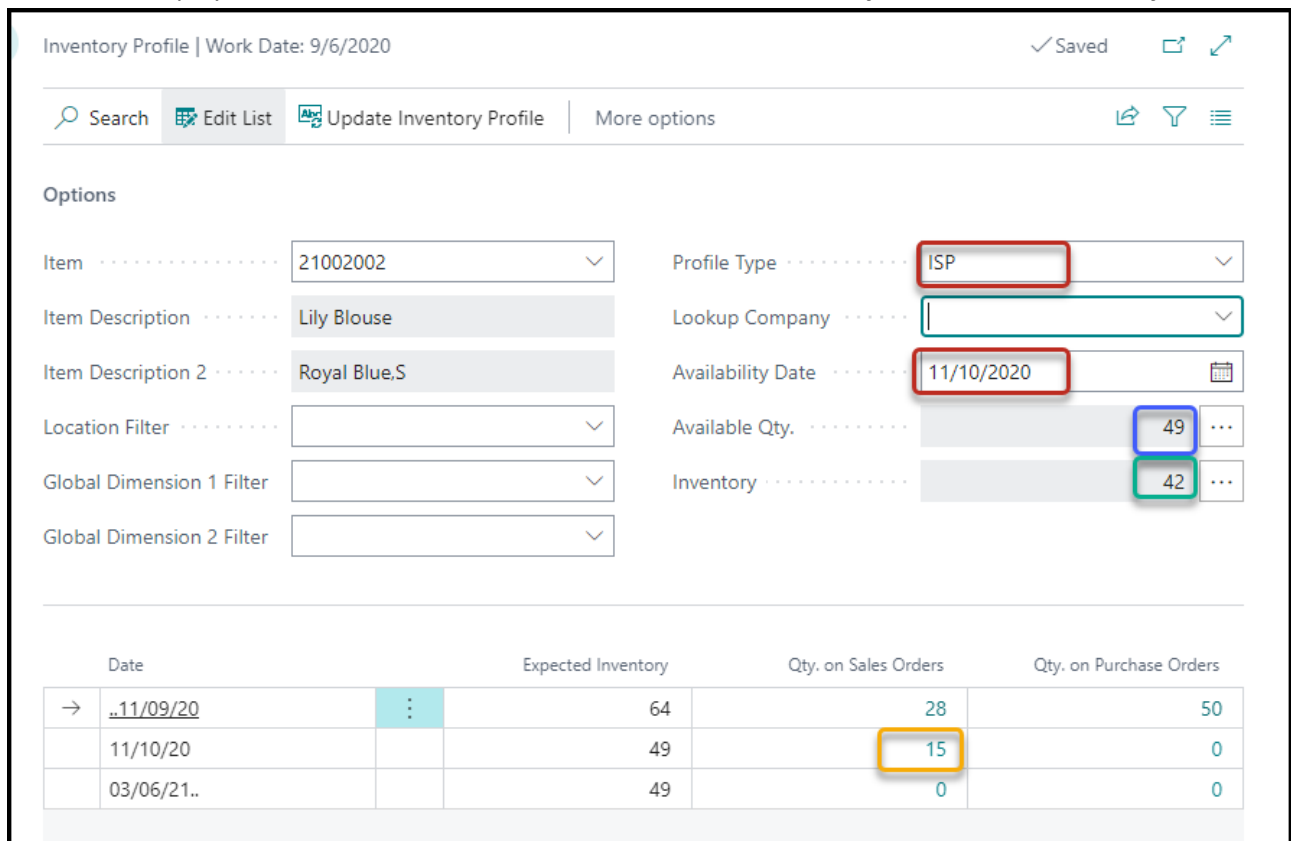

This field **Location Filter** can be filled automatically with the **Location Code** of the **Sales Line** if the parameter **Availability Check per Location** in **Sales & Receivables Setup** is set to Yes.

When Intercompany is used, the Profile Lines will show quantities that are summarized across the selected companies. When using the **Lookup value** in a field of the shown matrix, only Orders from the selected company will be shown. 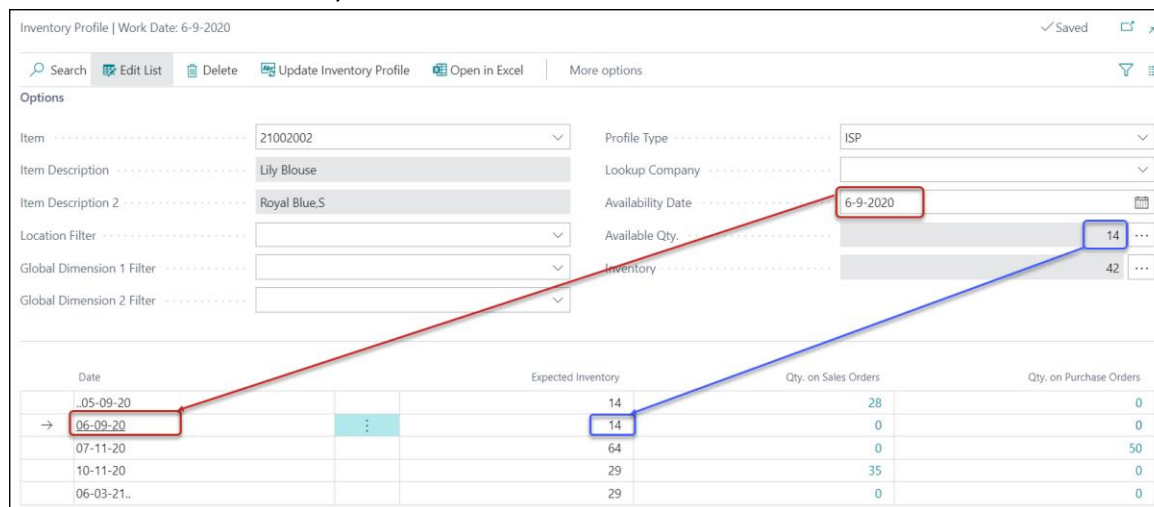

The default for **Availability Date** is determined from where the **Inventory Profile** is called.

- When called from **Sales Line**, the **Availability Date** is set to the **Shipment Date** from the **Sales Line**.
- When called from **Purchase Line**, the **Availability Date** is set to the **Expected Receipt Date** from the **Purchase Line**.
- When called from **Production Order Header**, the **Availability Date** is set to the **Availability Date** from the **Production Order Header**.
- When called from **Production Order Line**, the **Availability Date** is set to the **Starting Date** from the **Production Order Line**.
- When called from **Production Collecting Order Line**, the **Availability Date** is set to the **Availability Date** from the **Production Collecting Order Line**.
- When called from **Item**, the **Availability Date** is set to the **Work Date**

CALCULATION OF DATES

The Inventory Profile is calculated for a specific period called **Horizon**. The **Horizon Availability Check** determines the length of the Horizon. This field is found on the following places – as discussed in [Setups](#):

- Order Types
- Inventory Profile Type
- Item Card
- Master Card
- Inventory Setup

The system will look for a Horizon in the following sequence:

1. Order Types
2. Inventory Profile Type
3. Item Card/Master Card
4. Inventory Setup

The **Starting Date** for the Horizon is **TODAY** (Work Date in the Business Central database)

The **Ending Date** for the Horizon is **TODAY + Horizon Availability Check**.

If **Horizon Availability Check** has no value, the horizon is indefinite 31-12-9999 (December 31st 9999).

EXAMPLE 5:**TODAY** = *June 2, 2023***Horizon Availability Check** = *10W* (10 weeks)**Ending Date** = *August 11, 2023*

The Inventory Profile will then calculate all Orders in the period from *June 2, 2023*, to *August 11, 2023*, and enter the totals per Date in the **Inventory Profile** page.

EXAMPLE 6:**TODAY** = *June 2, 2023***Horizon Availability Check** = *" (blank)***Ending Date** = *December 31, 9999*

The Inventory Profile will then calculate all Orders found from *June 2, 2023*, and enter all the totals per date in the **Inventory Profile** page.

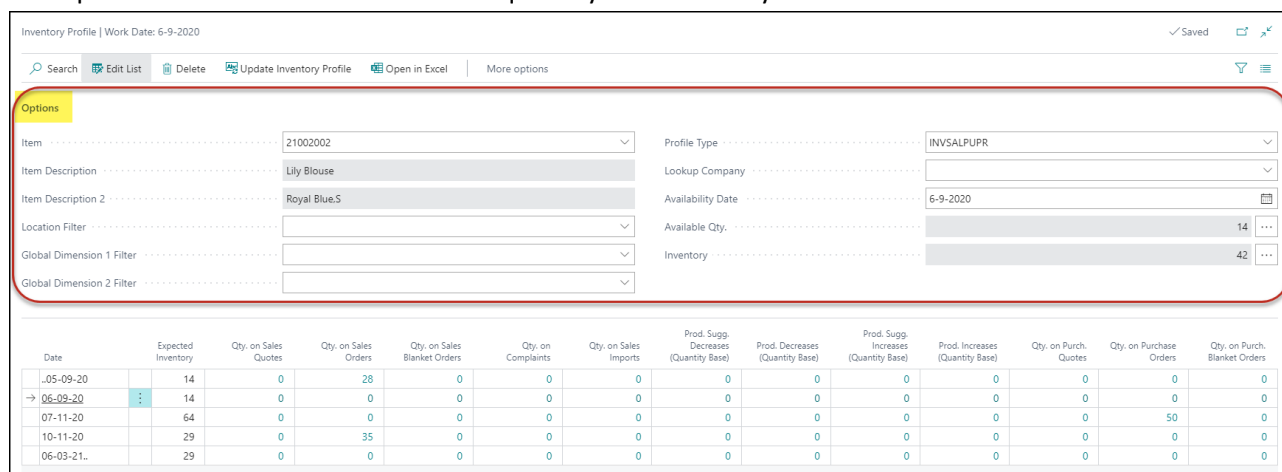
The **Item Inventory Profile** (hereafter known as Inventory Profile) opens in a window, showing both Header and Lines. In the Header area, it is possible to change filtering and view information.

In the Lines area, the Expected Inventory and Transactions per Date are shown.

The following will describe the Header and Lines areas.

HEADER (FASTTAB OPTIONS)

The **Header** is where the Inventory Profile Calculation is defined. Each of the fields defines a setting or filter that specifies the calculation of available quantity and Inventory.

DESCRIPTION OF THE FIELDS

ITEM

Here you can enter the **Item** for which you want to see the Inventory Profile. When called from an Item or a Document Line with an Item, the selected Item number will be entered as default.

The **Item Description** and **Item Description 2** will be shown based on the **Item**.

LOCATION FILTER

Here you can enter a Filter for Location Codes. The selected Location Codes will work as a filter, so that only Document Lines registered for this Location Code are shown.

This field can be filled by default. See [Location Filter](#)

GLOBAL DIMENSION 1 FILTER

Here you can enter a Filter for the **Global Dimension 1**. The selected Global Dimension 1 will work as a filter, so that only Document Lines registered for this Global Dimension 1 is shown.

GLOBAL DIMENSION 2 FILTER

Here you can select a Filter for the **Global Dimension 2**. The selected Global Dimension 2 will work as a filter, so that only Document Lines registered for this Global Dimension 2 is shown.

PROFILE TYPE

Here you can select the **Inventory Profile Setup**, which will influence the type of Document Lines that will be taken into the Inventory Profile.

This field can be filled by default based on [Standard Inventory Profile Setup](#) in Sales & Receivables Setup or [Inventory Profile Setup](#) in User ID or [Inventory Profile Setup](#) in Order Type.

LOOKUP COMPANY

Here you can select for which company in the same database, you want to see the Document Lines if you **Lookup value** in one of the quantities. Only Companies, which are setup as **Intercompany Relations** will be available to select. Therefore, this is only applicable if you have setup **TRIMIT Intercompany**.

AVAILABILITY DATE

Here you can select the **Date** for which you wish to see the available quantities. This Date is automatically set depending on how the Inventory Profile is opened.

AVAILABLE QUANTITY

Here you can see the total Available Quantity of the Item within the filters and on the **Availability Date**. If you click **Lookup value**, you will see per Date what the Available Quantity is; even including future demands/receipts as well.

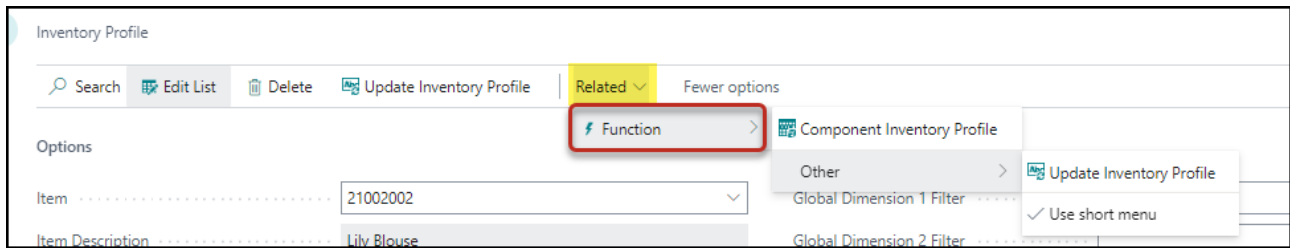

This function opens the **Inventory Profile Components** if applicable to the Item for which you see the Inventory Profile (see [Inventory Profile Components](#)).

UPDATE INVENTORY PROFILE

This function will re-calculate all the quantities.

INVENTORY PROFILE COMPONENTS

The **Inventory Profile Components** opens in a window, showing both Header and Lines. In the Header, it is possible to change filtering and view information. In the Lines, the Expected Inventory and Transactions are shown. The Header is like the Header of the Item Inventory Profile. The Lines show availabilities for the Item and for the Components that have the same **Management Level** as the **Management Level Sales** of the Item.

The following will describe the Lines.

MANAGEMENT LEVELS

The Inventory Profile Components is an option for Items with Bill of Materials (BOM), where one or more Components in the BOM are responsible for the Available Quantity of the Item.

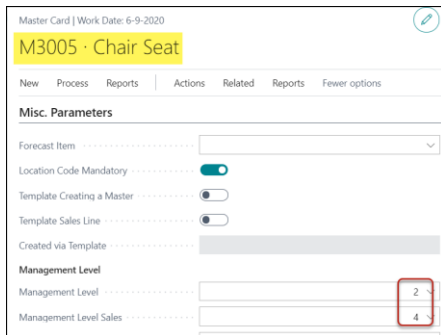

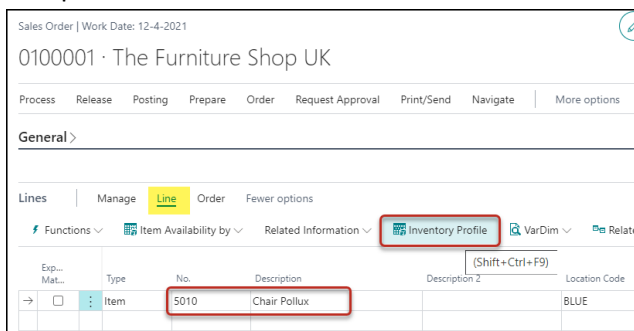

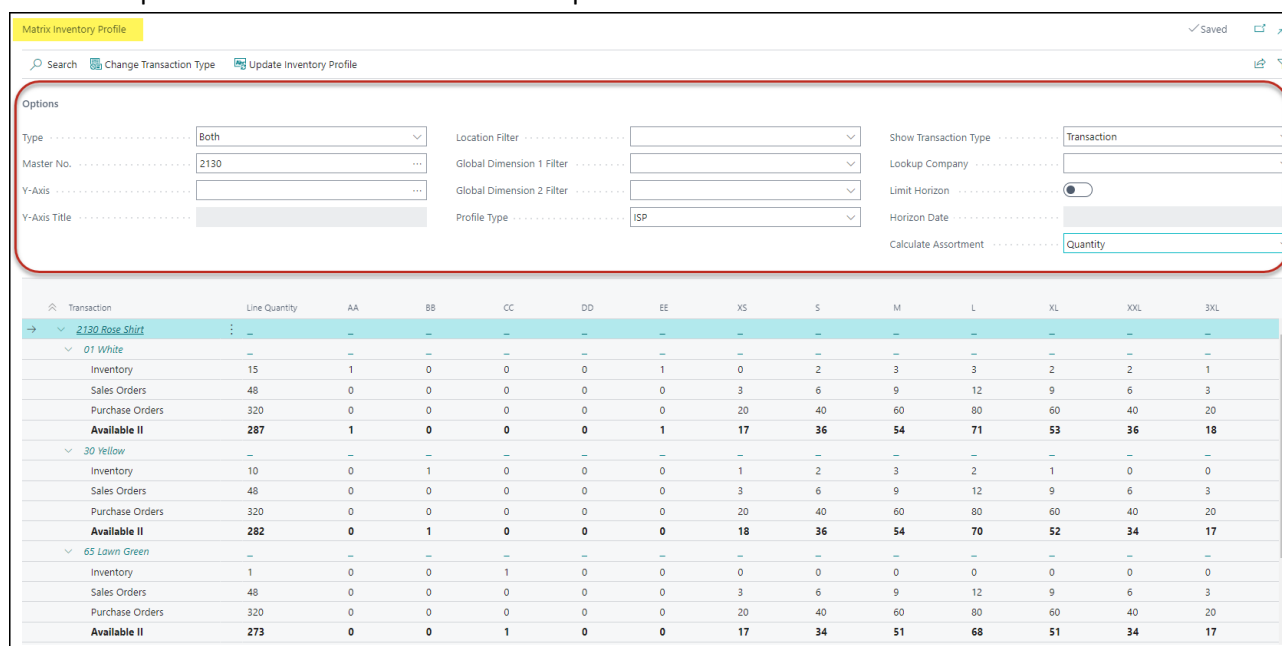
MATRIX INVENTORY PROFILE

The **Matrix Inventory Profile** is used to show Inventory of Matrix Items, the Profile can be called from the Master List/Card or from the Matrix Order Lines.

The **Matrix Inventory Profile** opens in a window, showing both Header and Lines. In the Header, it is possible to change filtering and view information. In the Lines, the Inventory and Orders are shown. The following will describe the Header and Lines.

HEADER (FASTTAB OPTIONS)

The **Header** area is where the Inventory Profile calculation is defined. Each of the fields defines a setting or filter that specifies the calculation of available quantities.

TYPE

Here you can select if the Matrix Inventory Profile is shown for a *Matrix* (which means the 'normal' colors and sizes of a product), an *Assortment Matrix* (instead of the sizes above the columns, you will see the different Assortments) or for *Both*.

The *Assortment Matrix* is only applicable if the **Master No.** has a separate Assortment Matrix.

If you select *Both*, you will see the regular Matrix, but also the Assortment Matrix quantities. The names of the Columns will depend on the Line that you are standing on.

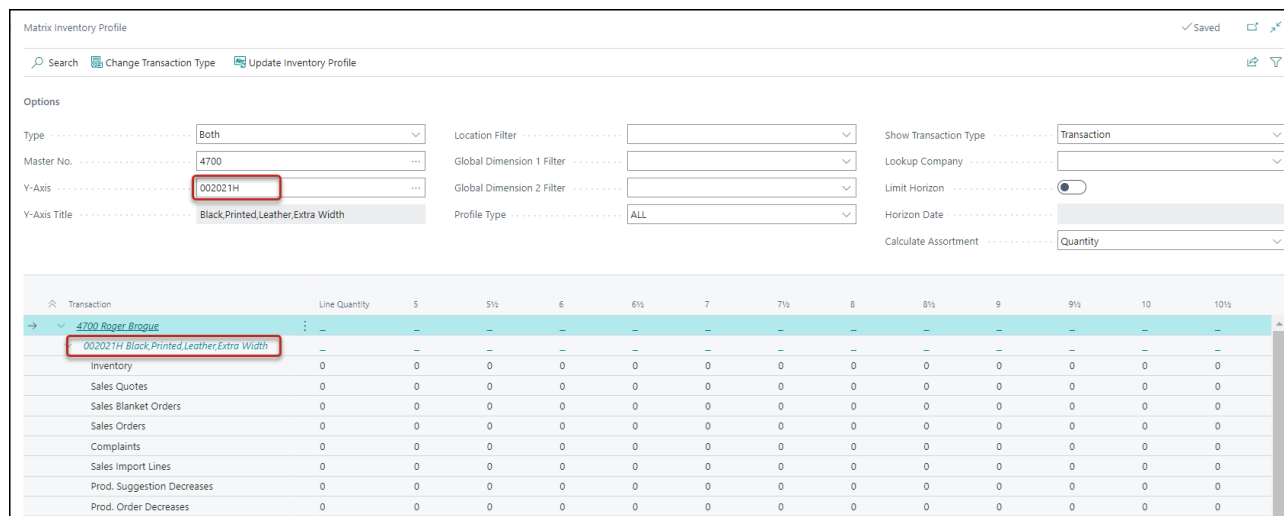

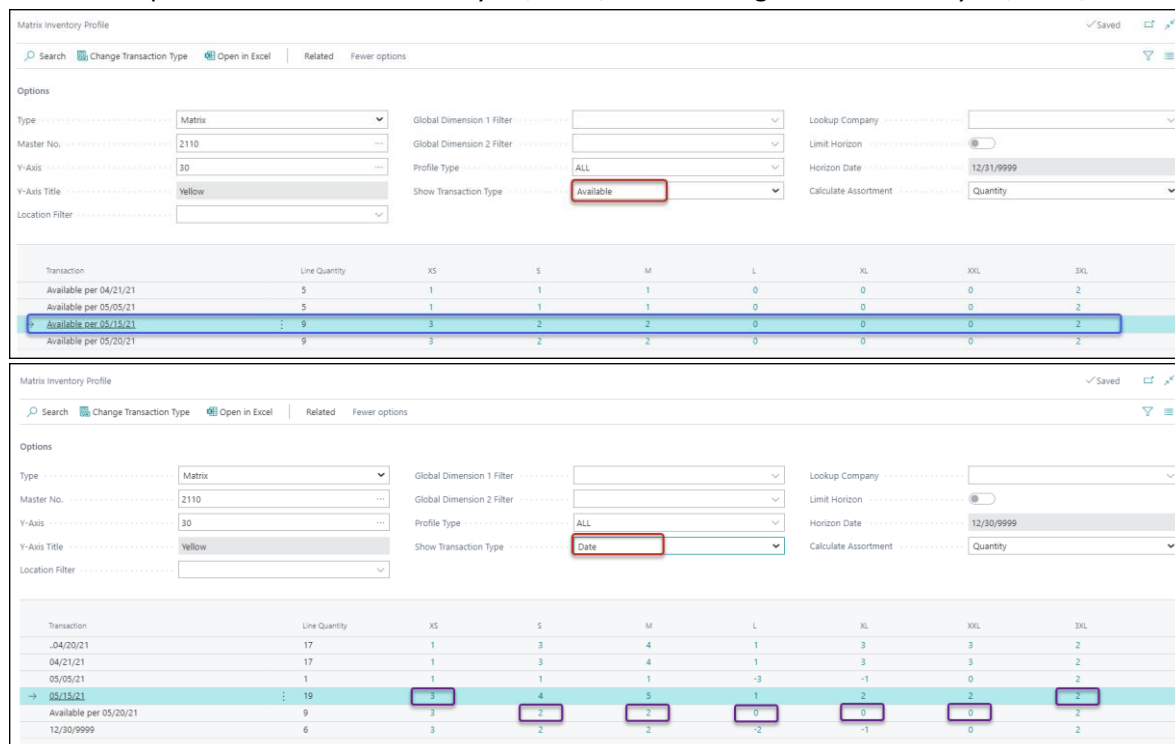

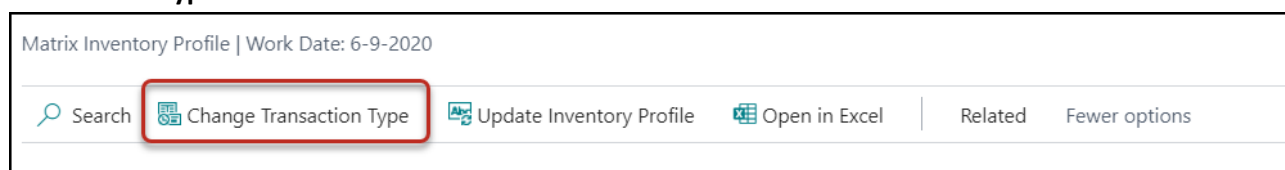

This field can by default be filled with the **Transaction Type Default** from a chosen **Profile Type**.

LOOKUP COMPANY

Here you can select to see Document Lines from another company in the same database. Only Companies, where TRIMIT Intercompany is setup, will be available to select.

LIMIT HORIZON

This field will determine if you want to limit the Transactions (when **Show Transaction Type** is *Transaction*) based on the **Horizon Availability Check** that the system determines.

If you do not enter a checkmark, the **Matrix Inventory Profile** will simply show all existing Transactions.

Especially if you are only interested in the availability in a limited period (Horizon), it will make sense to enter a checkmark in this field.

HORIZON DATE

This field will show the Date of the calculated Horizon if you have set the **Limit Horizon** to *Yes*; it cannot be changed.

CALCULATE ASSORTMENT

This field will determine which Quantities you will see regarding Assortments

You can choose between the following three options:

Quantity	This will simply show the quantities of the Assortments itself.
Pieces	This will show the quantity of pieces within the Assortments itself. I.e., an Assortment has 1S, 2M, 2L, 1XL; then if 1 Assortment is available, it will show 6 instead of 1 – as it would show if you chose the option <i>Quantity</i>
Split Assortment	This will not show the quantities of the Assortments but will split (explode the BOM of the Assortment) the Assortment into the individual Sizes. I.e., an Assortment has 1S, 2M, 2L, 1XL; then if 1 Assortment is available, it will show these quantities under the regular Sizes S, M, L and XL.

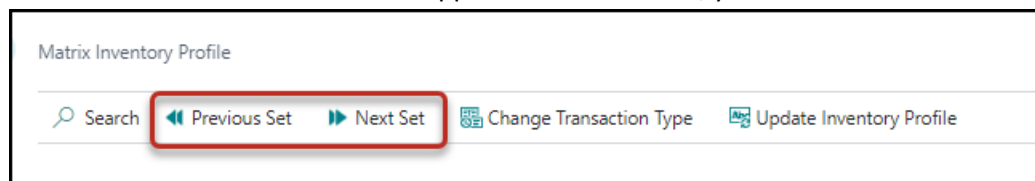

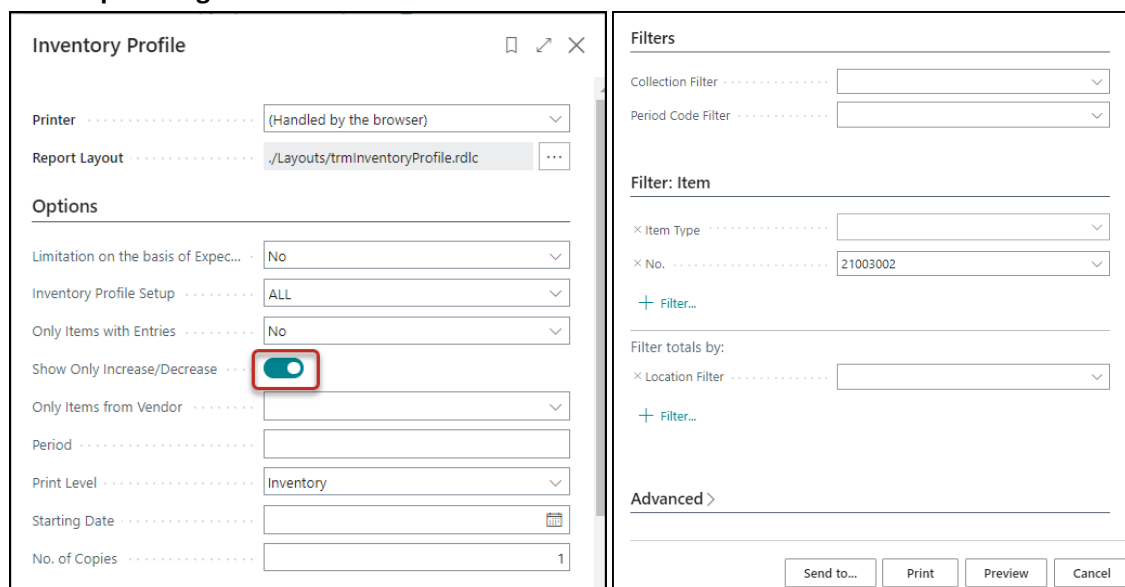

This report will go through all the Sales Lines with **Replenishment Policy** = *Inventory* and recalculate the Availability Check. When running through the Sales Lines (based on the filters of the Items), the system can move the **Shipment Date** to when it is possible that it can be shipped.

Therefore, if any changes have occurred regarding the **Expected Receipt Date** of Purchase Orders or **End Date** of Production Orders, these can adjust the Sales Lines.

It will however never change a Shipment Date earlier than the one entered when creating the Sales Line. The **Shipment Date** will – when running the Rescheduling, and if the Date will be changed – be moved to a field called **Original Shipment Date**, so on the next runs of this report, it will use that **Original Shipment Date** again for the Availability Check.

This report can also easily be used in a Job Queue.

DESCRIPTION OF THE FIELDS:

DATEFORMULA FOR MAX. MOVE OF SHIPMENT DATE

This is the “Controlling Date” if nothing is available – if this parameter is not filled it will use the **Horizon Availability Check** as the Availability Check does normally.

The default is automatically set to *6M+CM* but can be changed.

It determines – based on the Work Date – how far the Shipment Date of a Sales Line can be pushed forward if there is no availability.

EXAMPLE

I copied Master 2010 to 2011 by using the Wizard.
