TRIMIT Pick and Reallocation 22.1

This document contains information about the Pick and Reallocation functionality in TRIMIT 22.1 for Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central 2022, Wave 1 (W1).

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INTRODUCTION

With **TRIMIT Pick and Reallocation**, the deliveries to the Customers can be handled.

Based on the open Sales Orders, the available quantities of Items and the Customers Allocation Priorities, the system can determine which Items can be delivered to the Customers.

Using the Reallocation function users can interfere in the automatic assignment of available quantities of Items to the different Sales Lines within a TRIMIT Pick Documents.

The **TRIMIT Pick Document** is in no way comparable with the **Inventory Pick** or **Warehouse Pick** from Business Central.

Based on a **TRIMIT Pick Document** you are however able to create the **Warehouse Shipment**, or an **Inventory Pick** based on the fields in your Location Code.

The functionality described is the functionality as of **TRIMIT 22.1 for Business Central W1 BC20.X**.

The pictures in this White Paper are based on the demo database for **TRIMIT 22.1**, which is based on Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central 2022 Release Wave 1, in the demo company **CRONUS TRIMIT W1 Ltd.** (based on CRONUS International Ltd. of Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central).

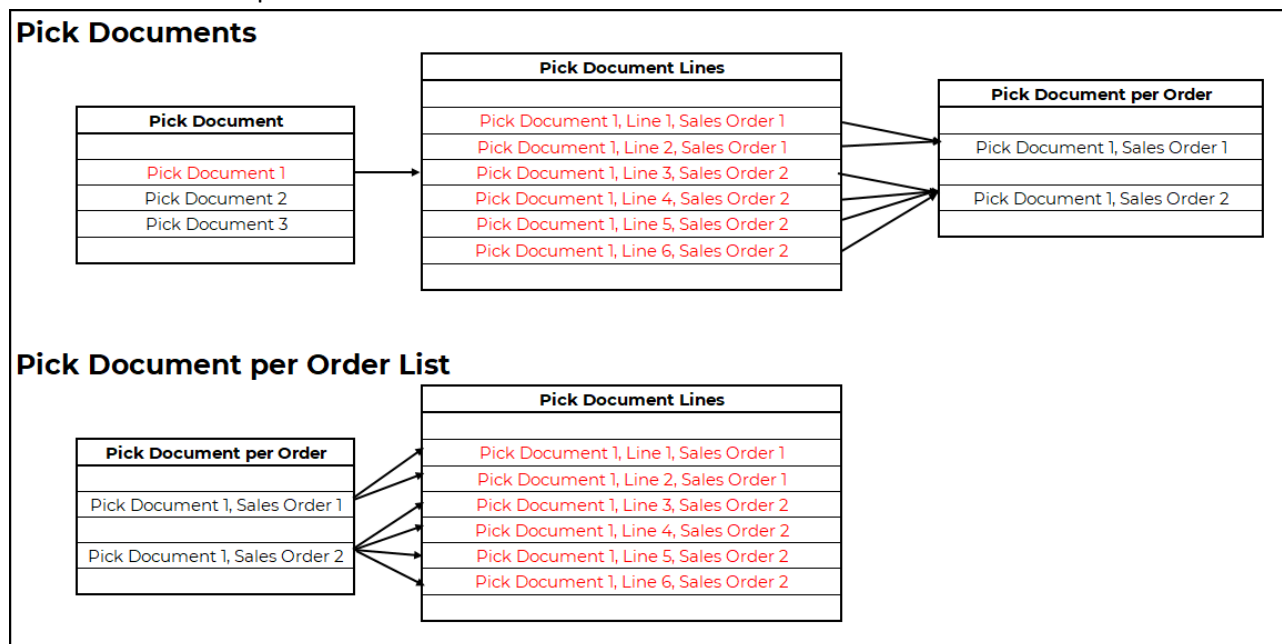

The initiator of the TRIMIT Pick Document is the report **Create Sales Order Pick** that creates Pick Documents, TRIMIT Pick Document Lines and TRIMIT Pick Documents per Order according to the structure below. By posting of the TRIMIT Pick Document, the table data are transferred to corresponding tables for posted data of the Shipment (and Invoice depending on a parameter in Inventory Setup).

Create Sales Order Pick:

- Creates Pick Document Header
- Creates Pick Document Lines
- Creates Pick per Order

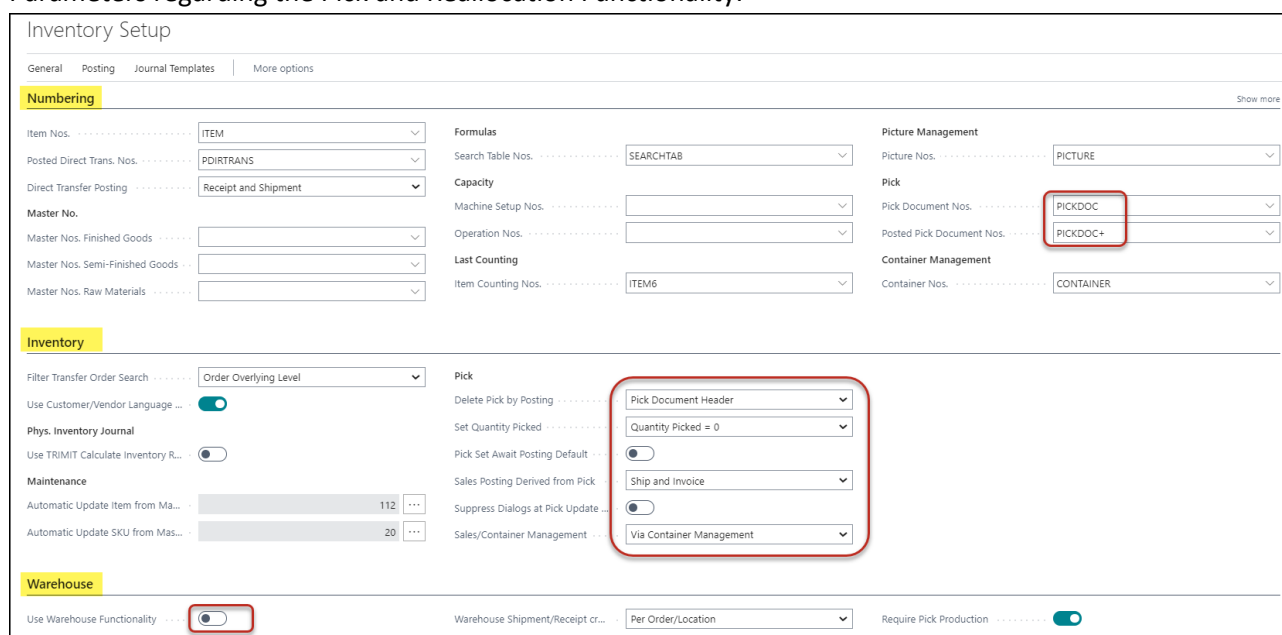


SETUPS

INVENTORY SETUP

Via **Tell me Inventory Setup**, you can open the **Inventory Setup** page, where you can find the following Parameters regarding the Pick and Reallocation Functionality.

PICK DOCUMENT NOS.

The No. Series for the Pick Document numbers.

POSTED PICK DOCUMENT NOS.

The No. Series for the Posted Pick Document numbers.

DELETE PICK BY POSTING

This Parameter can be used to determine when **Pick Document Lines** shall be deleted.

You can choose between the following three options.

Pick Document Header	Pick Document Lines, Pick per Order and Pick Document Header will be deleted after posting, when all the Lines related to the Pick Document Header are posted.
Pick Document per Order	Pick Document Lines and Pick per Order will be deleted after posting, when all the Lines related to the Pick per Order (same Sales Order) are posted.
Pick Line	Pick Document Lines will be deleted concurrently after the posting. Pick Document per Order will be deleted after posting, when all Pick Document Lines related to the Pick Document per Order are posted and Pick Document Header will be deleted after posting, when all the Pick Document Lines related to the Pick Document Header are posted.

NOTE

If Pick Document Lines cannot be deleted because of a partly delivery, you always need to delete it manually.
The setting of this Parameter is also important when you determine for what level you want to create Pick Documents – per Customer, per Ship-To Code or per Master. This is handled in the Pick Limitations.

SET QUANTITY PICKED

This Parameter is used when creating **Pick Document Lines** and determines the method of reporting **Quantity Picked (Base)** back to the Pick Document Lines.

You can choose between the following two options:

Quantity Picked = 0	When a Pick Document Line is created, Quantity Picked (Base) will be set to 0 (zero) and must be updated before posting. You must choose this option if you are using Bar Codes for the picking, if you want to use the Reallocation function or if you also use the WMS functionality of standard Business Central.
Quantity Picked = Quantity to be Picked	When a Pick Document Line is created, Quantity Picked (Base) will be set the same value as Quantity to be Picked (Base) . At the same time, the field Picked Quantity Updated will be set to Yes and the Pick Document Line is ready to be posted. You can adjust Quantity Picked (Base) before posting the Line.

PICK SET AWAIT POSTING DEFAULT

Especially when using TRIMIT Intercompany, you might want to prevent the Pick Document in the sales company to be posted before the head office company has posted theirs.

That is why you can set this Parameter to Yes, so the field **Await Posting** in the Pick Document Line will get a checkmark by default, and you need to take extra actions (could also be a customized report) before the Pick Document Line can be posted. For more details, see **White Paper – TRIMIT Intercompany**.

SALES POSTING DERIVED FROM PICK

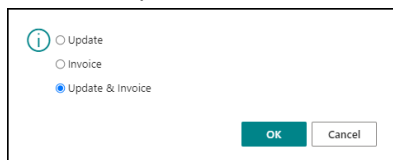
When posting a Pick Document Line, the system automatically posts the related Sales Order Line.

This Parameter is used to determine whether the posting of the Pick Document shall generate only Posted Sales Shipment or both Posted Sales Shipment and Posted Sales Invoice.

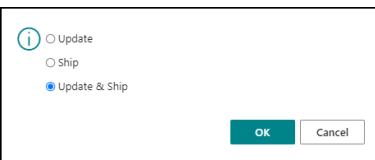
Ship and Invoice	Posting a Pick Document Line will create both a Posted Sales Shipment Line and a Posted Sales Invoice Line.
Ship	Posting a Pick Document Line will only create a Posted Sales Shipment Line.

SUPPRESS DIALOGS AT PICK UPDATE & POSTING

A checkmark in this Parameter will suppress the Dialog when posting a Pick Document Header or a Pick Document per Order:



or



It will automatically choose the third option *Update & Invoice* or *Update & Ship* depending on the content of the **Sales Posting Derived from Pick** Parameter.

This could be important if you want to add the posting of Pick Documents via a Job Queue or if you want to post several TRIMIT Pick Documents at once.

SALES/CONTAINER MANAGEMENT

With this Parameter, you can determine how you want to use the Container Management features for Sales. It has no influence on Purchase.

You can choose between the following two options:

Via Container Management	In the Container Management, you can select the Sales Lines and the quantities of the Sales Lines that are in a specific Container.
Via Pick	Container Nos. can be attached to a TRIMIT Pick Document Header. This means that all the picked quantities of a TRIMIT Pick Document will be in the same Container.

For more details, see **White Paper – TRIMIT Container Management**.

USE WAREHOUSE FUNCTIONALITY

If this Parameter is Yes, you can use the advanced Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central WMS functionality in combination with the TRIMIT functionalities.

This will influence the Fields and Actions that you will see in several pages.

This Parameter can not be set to Yes, if you did not set the **Check Availability by Location** in the Sales & Receivables Setup to Yes.

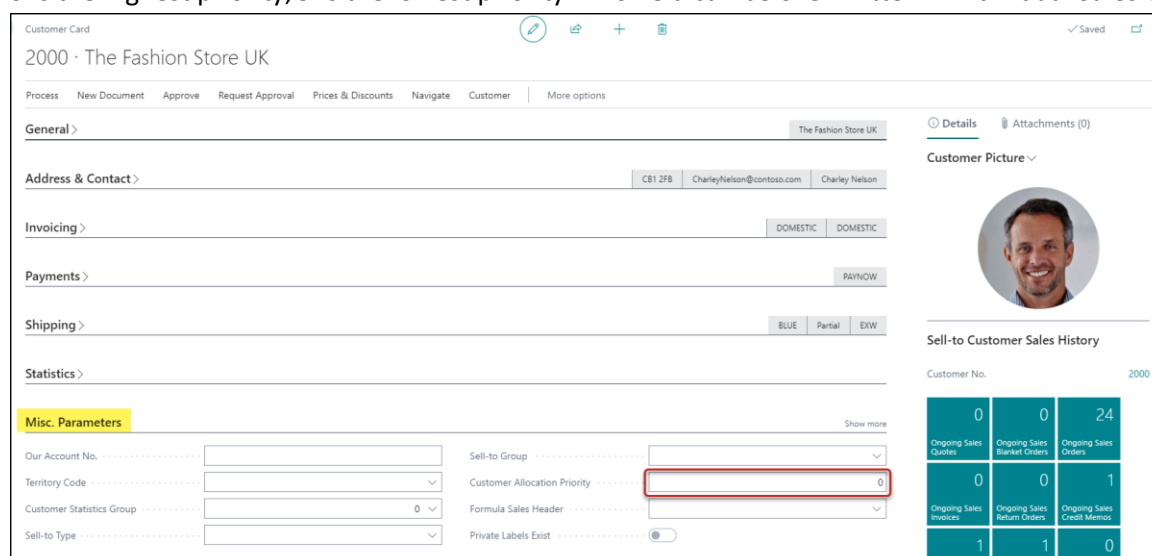
CUSTOMER CARD

Via **Tell me Customers**, in the Customer Card, the following field is related to the Pick and Reallocation Functionality.

CUSTOMER ALLOCATION PRIORITY

Here you can set a ranking (an Integer) for your Customers, which will influence how the available quantity of Items is assigned to the Sales Orders.

In the report **Create Sales Order Pick Document** you can determine in which order the available quantity should be assigned to open Sales Order Lines: bases on **Order Date** (Ascending) / Sales Order No. (Ascending) or based on **Customer Allocation Priority** (Ascending) / Sales Order No. (Ascending). 0 is the highest priority, 9 is the lowest priority. This field can be overwritten in individual Sales Orders.

PICK DOCUMENT LIMITATIONS

Via **Tell me Pick Document Limitations**, you can find the **Pick Document Limitations**.

When creating Pick Documents, you can use the **Pick Document Limitations** to setup a combination of filters, that you regularly will use when creating Pick Documents and you determine for which level Pick Documents will be created.

If you do not create **Pick Document Limitations**, it means that all possible Sales Order Lines will be created as Pick Document Lines on 1 single Pick Document.

DESCRIPTION OF THE FIELDS

LIMITATION CODE

The Key field and Code of the Pick Document Limitation. New Codes can be inserted by clicking **+New**.

DESCRIPTION

Text field for a **Description** of the Limitation Code.

FILTER POST CODE

This filter refers to the field **Ship-to Post Code** in the Sales Header.

FILTER COUNTRY/REGION CODE

This filter refers to the field **Sell-to Country/Region Code** in the Sales Header.

FILTER SHIPPING AGENT

This filter refers to the field **Shipping Agent Code** in the Sales Header.

FILTER CUSTOMER

This filter refers to the field **Sell-to Customer No.** in the Sales Header.

FILTER LOCATION

This filter refers to the field **Location Code** on the Sales Lines.

FILTER BIN

This filter refers to the field **Bin Code** on the Sales Lines.

FILTER CUSTOMER ALLOCATION PRIORITY

This filter refers to the field **Customer Allocation Priority** in the Sales Header.

This field on the Sales Header was default filled with the **Customer Allocation Priority** on the Customer Card but can be changed on individual Sales Orders.

FILTER ORDER TYPE

This filter refers to the field **Order Type** in the Sales Header.

CREATE PICK DOCUMENT PER SELL-TO CUSTOMER

☐	All Pick Document Lines will be created on the same Pick Document No.

CREATE PICK DOCUMENT PER SHIP-TO CUSTOMER

☐	All Pick Document Lines will be created on the same Pick Document No.
☒	Per Sell-To Customer No. + Ship-To Code in the Sales Header within the filters a new Pick Document No. will be created

CREATE PICK DOCUMENT PER MASTER

☐	All Pick Document Lines will be created on the same Pick Document No.
☒	Per Master in the Sales Line within the filters a new Pick Document No. will be created

NOTE 1

Of the three options above you can make different combinations:

If **Pick Document per Sell-To Customer** and **Pick Document per Ship-To Customer** are ☒ it means:

Per Sell-To Customer+Ship-To Code, a Pick Document will be created.

This is the same outcome as when you only have a Yes on the Ship-To Customer.

If **Pick Document per Sell-To Customer** and **Pick per Master** are ☒ it means:

Per Sell-To Customer+Master, a Pick Document will be created.

If **Pick Document per Ship-To Customer** and **Pick per Master** are ☒ it means:

Per Sell-To Customer+Ship-To Customer/Master, a Pick Document will be created.

NOTE 2

Especially **Create Pick Document per Master** set to ☒, will give you the opportunity to re-allocate assigned Inventory over the Sales Orders after the Pick Documents have been created. See [Reallocation](#) for more details.

PICK SET AWAIT POSTING DEFAULT

This field will overrule the field in the **Inventory Setup**.

Specifically regarding TRIMIT Intercompany but could also be used in a normal company.

Setting this field to Yes, means that created Pick Document Lines will get a checkmark in the field **Await Posting**, meaning that the Pick Document Lines cannot be posted until this field is set to No.

This needs to be done with an extra customized report in which you can setup your own rules.

Regarding Intercompany: for more details, see **White Paper – TRIMIT Intercompany**

COMPANY

If you enter the Name of a Company in this field, only for this Company, the Pick Documents will be created.

This field is not by default visible; you need to add it via **Personalize**

This fields can be used especially regarding **TRIMIT Intercompany** and creating Pick Documents in the *Headquarter*, in which you i.e., first might want to create Pick Documents for the *Headquarter* and in a second run the Pick Documents for the *Subsidiaries*.

For more details, see the **White Paper – TRIMIT Intercompany**.

PICK AND REALLOCATION PROCESS

The Pick and Reallocation Process can be split into the following steps:

- 1) Create the Pick Document Nos.
Based on the Sales Orders you can create TRIMIT Pick Document Nos. using **Create Sales Order Pick Document**. You can use the **Pick Document Limitations** to determine what can be combined on the same TRIMIT Pick Document No.
- 2) Maintain the assigned quantities to pick → Reallocation
Then you have the option to see what is on the TRIMIT Pick Documents in two different views:
Pick Documents and **Pick Document per Order List**
- 3) In all views you can change the quantities that are assigned to the different Sales Lines and use the functionality for Reallocation.
- 4) Choose the Item Tracking Lines to the Pick Document Lines (if applicable)
- 5) Create the **Warehouse Shipment** or **Inventory Pick** (if applicable)
- 6) Post the Pick Document Nos. - if not already posted via 5)

When the goods are picked, you can post the Pick Document No. (or parts of it).

Based on the option when posting (*Ship* or *Ship & Invoice*) the Shipment will be posted and the Invoice will be created and posted.

NOTE 1

The TRIMIT Pick Document is in the beginning in no way related to the standard Shipments and Picks from Business Central. You can however create a **Warehouse Shipment** or **Inventory Pick** based on a Pick Document.

In that case, the TRIMIT Pick Document will become more a pick proposal that can be influenced and will become the base for further WMS actions.

NOTE 2

In case you might also have installed **Tasklet Factory**, it is important to install also the

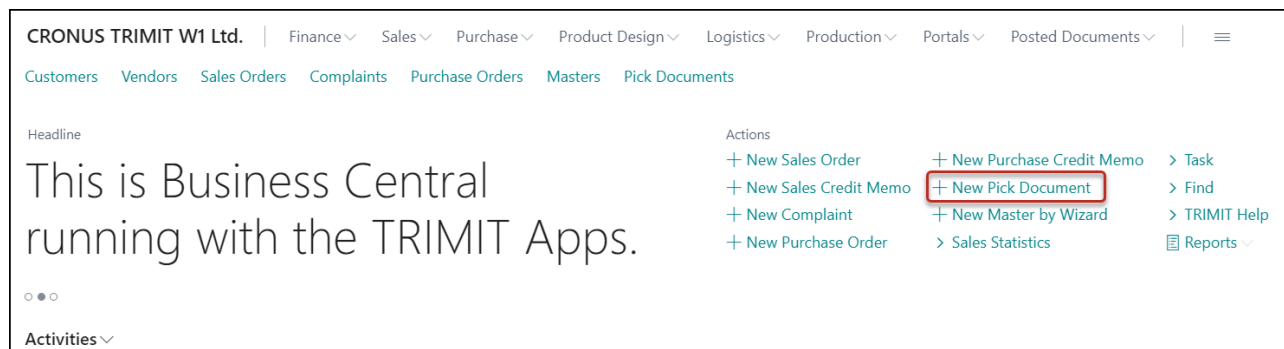
TRIMIT Development AS_TRIMIT AddOn Mobile WMS App, which can be found on our Partner Portal if you want to use the **TRIMIT Pick Document per Order** for picking Items via **Tasklet Factory** instead of picking **Sales Order Lines** or (WMS) **Pick Lines**.

CREATE PICK DOCUMENTS

Via **Tell me Create pick** you can find the Report **Create Sales Orders Pick Document**.

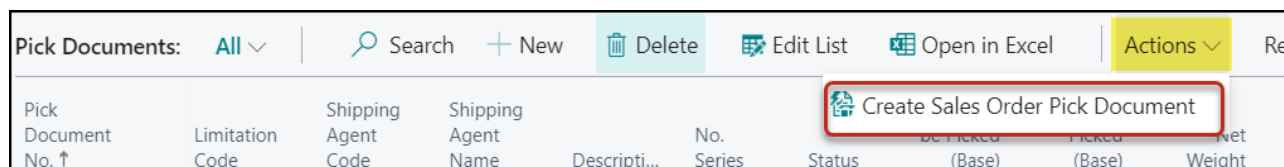
With this report you can create Pick Documents.

This report is also added to the **Role Center (Profile) TRM_SB TRIMIT Small Business** as the action **+ New Pick Document**:



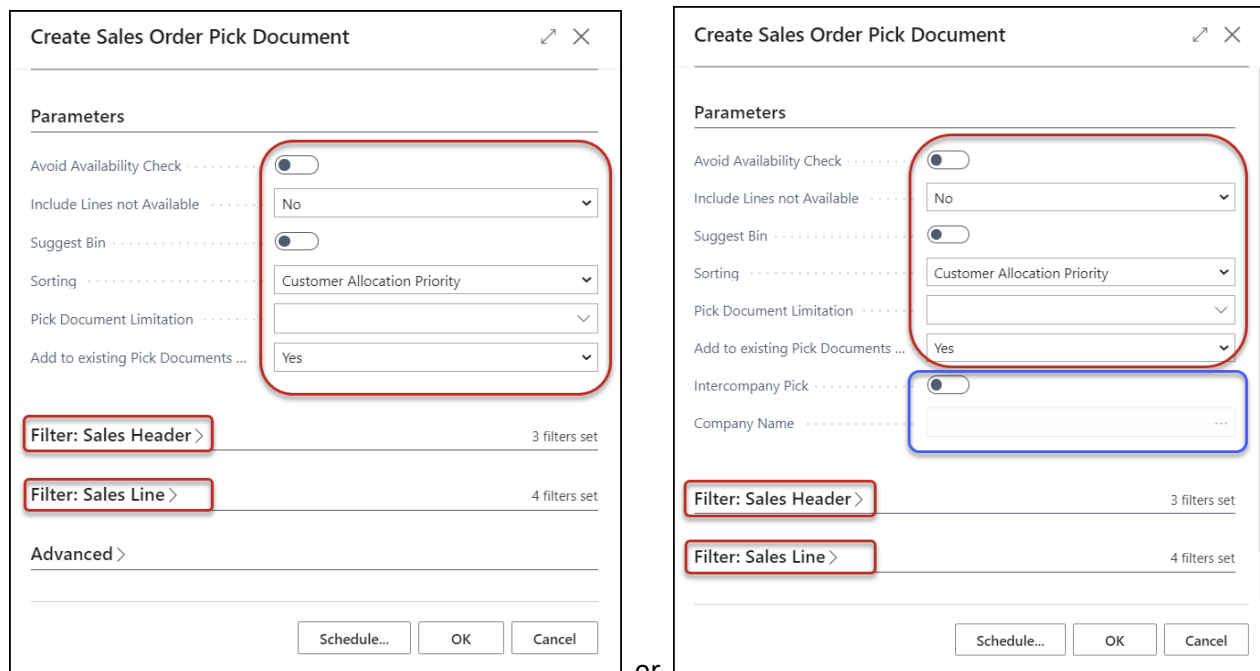

NOTE

The right Request Page is only applicable in a TRIMIT Intercompany Structure in the *Headquarter* where in the **Intercompany Relation** of a *Subsidiary* the field **Intercompany Pick** has been set to *Yes*.

DESCRIPTION OF THE FIELDS

AVOID AVAILABILITY CHECK

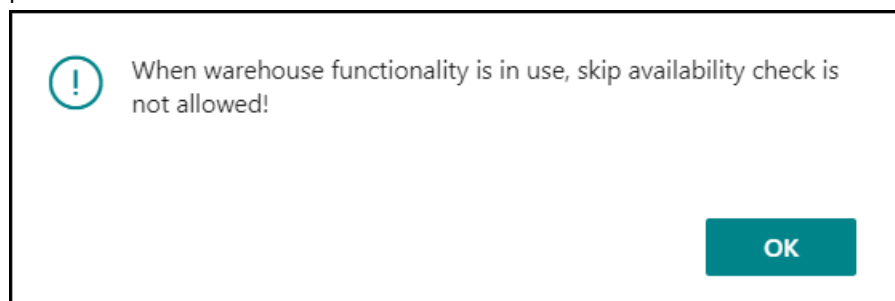
The availability check for creating Pick Documents differs from standard TRIMIT Availability Check.

The Pick availability check is simply a check of **Quantity to be Picked** compared to the current **Inventory Quantity – Quantity to be Picked** on existing **Pick Document Lines**.

☐	Availability check is carried out and only Sales Lines (within the Filters) for which there is enough Inventory – existing Pick Document Lines will be created as Pick Document Lines
☒	Availability check is avoided and for all Sales Lines (within the Filters) Pick Document Lines will be created.

NOTE

Avoid Availability Check must **not** be set, if you use a Location Code on your Sales Lines, in which the **Require Shipment** or **Require Pick** is set to Yes. In that case, you would get an error message, if you enter a checkmark in the parameter:



INCLUDE LINES NOT AVAILABLE

If **Avoid Availability Check** is ☐, you could get many created Pick Document Lines, for which no quantities are available. This field determines if you want to see these Zero-Lines (the **Quantity to be Picked** and **Quantity Picked** will be Zero).

You can choose between the following five options:

No	Sales Lines with no availability will not be created as Pick Document Lines
All	All Sales Lines with no availability will be created as Pick Document Lines with 0 in Quantity to Pick
Master Inventory > 0	Only Sales Lines with no availability, for which the Master (so all Items of the Master) does have Inventory, will be created as Pick Document Lines with 0 in Quantity to Pick
Y-Axis Inventory > 0	Only Sales Lines with no availability, for which the Master + Y-Axis (in fashion usually per color) does have Inventory, will be created as Pick Document Lines with 0 in Quantity to Pick
Item Inventory > 0	Only Sales Lines with no availability, for which the Item does have Inventory, will be created as Pick Document Lines with 0 in Quantity to Pick

SUGGEST BIN

This field is only applicable if you do not use the full functionality of WMS but do have a checkmark in the field **Bin Mandatory** of the **Location Code** from a Sales Line.

In that case, when receiving Purchase Orders or Finishing Production Orders, you need to enter a **Bin Code**.

A checkmark in this field can then suggest the **Bin Code** in the Pick Document Lines. This can also result in more than one Pick Document Line for the same Sales Line with different **Bin Codes**.

☐	The system will not suggest the Bin Code in the Pick Document Lines, based on the Bin Content .
☒	The system will suggest the Bin Code in the Pick Document Lines, based on the Bin Content . This can also lead to several Pick Document Lines related to the same Sales Line.

SORTING

In this field you can determine in which sorting the Sales Lines will be checked to assign the available Inventory. In case of a TRIMIT Intercompany Structure, it is a Sorting over all the companies.

You can choose between the following three options:

Customer Allocation Priority	The Sales Lines will be sorted per Customer Allocation Priority and Order Date of the Sales Header to assign the available Inventory for creating the Pick Documents.
Order Date	The Sales Lines will be sorted per Order Date of the Sales Header to assign the available Inventory for creating the Pick Documents.
Alternative Sorting	The Sales Lines will be sorted per User Defined Sorting No. of the Sales Header to assign the available Inventory for creating the Pick Documents.

NOTE

Before assigning the available Inventory to create the Pick Documents, a temporary Table is filled: **6036335 trm Temp. Pick Priority** based on the filtered Sales Lines.

If you want to make use of the *Alternative Sorting*, you need to develop an event, to fill the **Alternative Sorting** field in the **Temp. Pick Priority** table based on your own criteria. This field is an Integer.

I.e., based on Credit Limit, the record in the **6036335 trm Temp. Pick Priority** might be deleted or get a high Integer for the **Alternative Sorting**.

You can find the calling of this event already in the Codeunit **6036780 trm Pick Handling**:

PICK DOCUMENT LIMITATION

The Code of the **Pick Document Limitations** as described in the section [Pick Document Limitations](#).

The Limitation Setup can work in three separate ways:

A Limitation Code is entered	The Pick Document Limitation works as a predefined filter, and Pick Document Nos. and Pick Document Lines are created according to the chosen Pick Document Limitation
Blank without records in the Pick Document Limitations	All records within the filters of the Report (Sales Header, Sales Lines) will be attached to the same Pick Document No.
Blank with records in the Pick Document Limitations	This creation of the Pick Document Nos. runs through all the Pick Document Limitations from top down and creates Pick Document Nos. according to the individual setups of the Pick Document Limitations. Example (a simple setup): Limitation 1 : Location Code filter = BLUE Limitation 2 : Location Code filter = RED Result: 3 Pick Document Nos. in Total: 1 Pick Document No. for Location Code BLUE 1 Pick Document No. for Location Code RED 1 Pick Document No. for the Pick Document Lines with different Location Codes than RED and BLUE If you also entered, that Pick Document Nos. should be created per Sell-To Customer, the system will create Nos. per Sell-To Customer per BLUE, RED and other Location Codes. When using the Pick Document Limitations in this way it is important to have the correct path through the Limitations, especially when multiple fields are in use per Limitation.

ADD TO EXISTING PICK DOCUMENTS WHERE STATUS=BLANK

If Pick Document Lines will be created for the Sales Lines: can Sales Lines be added to existing Pick Documents if the **Status** of the Pick Document = *Blank*.

You can decide to do this, if existing Pick Documents have not yet been given to the employees in the warehouse, so can still be changed based on a new calculation of what to be picked.

INTERCOMPANY PICK

This option will only be shown if there is an **Intercompany Relation** with **Relation Type** is set to *Create IC Sales (Automatic)* and **Intercompany Pick** is set to *Yes*.

This Parameter determines if Intercompany Pick Documents should be created.

This means, that in a TRIMIT Intercompany Structure, when creating Pick Documents in the *Headquarter* Company, also (Intercompany) Pick Documents can be created in the *Headquarter* Company for Sales Orders that are in the *Subsidiary*.

In that case, in the Intercompany Relations of the *Headquarter*, the *Subsidiary* needs to have a **Relation Type** of *Create IC Sales (Automatic)* and a checkmark in **Intercompany Pick**.

☐	No Pick Documents will be created for related companies in a TRIMIT Intercompany Structure.
☒	Pick Documents will be created for related companies in a TRIMIT Intercompany Structure if the field Intercompany Pick in the Intercompany Relation is set to <i>Yes</i> .

COMPANY NAME

This option will only be shown if there is an **Intercompany Relation** with **Relation Type** is set to *Create IC Sales (Automatic)* and **Intercompany Pick** is set to *Yes*.

If Parameter **Intercompany Pick** is *Yes*, you can select a Company within the TRIMIT Intercompany Structure for which you want to create the Pick Documents.

That could be the current company (i.e., only the *Headquarter*) or a related company (i.e., a *Subsidiary*) for which **Intercompany Pick** in the Intercompany Relations has been set to *Yes*.

More details regarding this Intercompany Pick procedure are described in the ***White Paper – TRIMIT Intercompany***.

MAINTAIN THE PICK DOCUMENT NOS.

After the Pick Document Nos. have been created, you can maintain the Pick Document Lines.

This can be done in different pages:

- **Pick Documents:** It will show all the Pick Document Nos. first, and then all the created Pick Document Lines of a Pick Document No. when you go into the Card of a Pick Document No.
- **Pick Document per Order List:** It will show lines per Pick Document/Sales Order, and then only the Pick Document Lines related to a Pick Document No. and a Sales Order when you go into the Card of a Line in this list.

PICK DOCUMENTS

Via **Tell me Pick Documents**, you can find the page of all the Pick Document Nos.

It can also be found directly in the **Role Center (Profiles) TRM_SB TRIMIT Small Business**.

PICK DOCUMENT NO.

The unique Number for this Pick Document.

DESCRIPTION

Default empty. You can enter a Description for this Pick Document.

STATUS

This field will only be set automatically (to *Ready to Post*) in case of using the TRIMIT Intercompany Structure when the Pick Documents in the *Headquarter* are posted, and therefore the related Pick Documents in the *Subsidiary* are also *Ready to Post*.

Otherwise, you can change it manually so you can use it for keeping track of the Status of your Pick Documents.

The available values are **blank**, **Planned**, **In Progress**, **Ready to Post** and **Completed**.

When the value of this field is changed to a higher value, the **Status** of the related Pick Document Lines will automatically be updated for all lines with lower Status value.

If the value of this field is changed to a lower value, you will be asked whether you want the **Status** of the related Pick Document Lines set to the new lower value.

Therefore, it is up to you to determine what the different values of the **Status** mean.

An example:

Blank	New created Pick Document
Planned	You could create a Pick Document to make a hard reservation of the Inventory for a specific Customer/Sales Order. In that case, the quantities on Inventory are not available for other Pick Documents anymore. This could be a situation to use the value <i>Planned</i> for.
In Progress	The Pick Document is now in the Warehouse and is now being picked.
Ready to Post	Goods are picked. Therefore, some of the Pick Document Lines can be posted. In case of TRIMIT Intercompany: Pick Documents in the <i>Headquarter</i> have been posted, and therefore, the related Pick Documents in the <i>Subsidiary</i> can be posted.
Completed	The Pick Document has been physically picked and can now be posted.

The meaning described above can however be whatever you want to use it for!

LIMITATION CODE

The **Pick Limitation Code** that has been chosen when the Pick Document has been created, or the **Pick Limitation Code** that has been determined during creation of the Pick Document. This cannot be changed.

The following two fields are only visible if **Use Warehouse Functionality** in the Inventory Setup is set to *Yes*.

WAREHOUSE SHIPMENT EXISTS

This field will be set automatically to *Yes* if a **Warehouse Shipment** has been created based on this Pick Document.

INVENTORY PICK EXISTS

This field will be set automatically to *Yes* if an **Inventory Pick** has been created based on this Pick Document.

The following four fields have been added to the page via **Personalize**:

ASSIGNED USER ID

In this field, you can enter the **User** that will pick the Items of this Pick Document in the Warehouse.

ASSIGNMENT DATE

Will be filled automatically when you fill the **Assigned User ID**.

ASSIGNMENT TIME

Will be filled automatically when you fill the **Assigned User ID**.

NOTE

The above three fields will also be copied to the Pick Document Lines, Pick per Order, and if applicable also to the Warehouse Shipment Header and Inventory Pick Header.

After a Warehouse Shipment or Inventory Pick might have been created, you are not able to change the **Assigned User ID** anymore.

NUMBER OF PICK PER ORDER

This will show the number of Sales Orders that are in this Pick Document Lines.

SHIPPING AGENT CODE

QUANTITY TO BE PICKED (BASE)

The total quantity that can be picked on this Pick Document – the sum of all **Quantity to be Picked (Base)** from the Lines.

CONTAINER NO.

Here you can enter a **Container No.** in which the goods of this Pick Document will be shipped. This is only possible if Parameter **Sales/Container Management** in the Inventory Setup is set to *Via Pick*.

In that case, also the **Container No.** in the Pick Documents Lines will be updated. This means that all the Lines will be in the same Container.

NOTE

For a detailed description of how you can use the **Container No.** please look at the **White Paper – TRIMIT Container Management**.

COMPANY INTERCOMPANY

This field will be set automatically, in the *Headquarter* within a TRIMIT Intercompany Structure, by the system. It will show the name of the Company for which this (Intercompany) Pick Document is created. This will not be the current Company *Headquarter*, but the name of one of the *Subsidiary(s)*.

In that case, the information on the Lines is related to Sales Orders in that specific *Subsidiary*.

This field will only be filled if you created **Intercompany Picks** in the *Headquarter* Company.

AWAIT DELETE INTERCOMPANY

This field will be set automatically by the system.

This field will get a checkmark when you Post the Pick Document No. in the *Headquarter* and there is a corresponding Pick Document No. in the *Subsidiary*.

It prevents deleting the Pick Document in the *Headquarter* before the corresponding Pick Document in the *Subsidiary* has been posted.

Some of the fields shown in above picture are not shown by default but need to be added via **Personalize** if you want to see/use them.

NOTE

In case you have set the Parameter **Use Warehouse Functionality** in the Inventory Setup to Yes, and the Location Code of the Pick Document Line is set for **Require Shipment** or **Require Pick**, you can only change the **Quantity Picked (Base)** indirectly via a created **Warehouse Shipment** or **Inventory Pick**.

In that case, the field **Quantity Picked (Base)** – and several other fields - cannot be changed manually on the Pick Document Line.

TYPE

While creating the Pick Document Lines during the report **Create Sales Order Pick Document** this field will always be set to *Item*.

SELL-TO CUSTOMER NO. AND SHIP-TO CODE

The **Sell-to Customer No.** and **Ship-to Customer** are based on the corresponding fields from the original Sales Line and cannot be changed.

CUSTOMER ALLOCATION PRIORITY

The **Customer Allocation Priority** of the Sales Order and cannot be changed.

NO., DESCRIPTION AND DESCRIPTION 2

The **No.** will always be an Item from the original Sales Line and cannot be changed.

Also, the **Description** and **Description 2** are copied from the original Sales Line and cannot be changed.

QUANTITY REQUESTED (BASE)

This is the remaining quantity of the original Sales Line and cannot be changed.

QUANTITY TO BE PICKED (BASE)

This is the quantity that the employee in the warehouse should pick. This quantity is calculated based on the available quantity for the picks (Inventory – quantity on other Pick Document Nos.). This quantity can be changed manually.

The suggested quantity depends on the Filters and Parameters of the **Create Sales Order Pick Document** report. You could run the report so that you get Pick Document Lines for all requested quantities, not only available quantities. However, **Quantity to be Picked (Base)** will be set to zero at the unavailable lines.

DIFFERENCE ON QUANTITY (BASE)

This is a calculated field based on **Quantity Requested (Base)** – **Quantity to be Picked (Base)** and can not be changed.

QUANTITY PICKED (BASE)

This is the quantity that really is picked in the warehouse to be shipped to the customer.

You can change this quantity manually or you can use the function as described below under [Set Picked Quantity = Quantity to Pick](#)

This quantity can already during the creation of the Pick Document Nos. be set automatically based on the Parameter [Set Quantity Picked](#) in the **Inventory Setup**.

This field can not be changed if **Warehouse Handling Type** is *Whse. Shipment* based on the fields of the **Location Code** of the Pick Document Line.

DIFFERENCE ON PICKED QUANTITY (BASE)

This is a calculated field based on **Quantity to be Picked (Base)** – **Quantity Picked (Base)** and will be calculated after changing the **Quantity Picked (Base)** (manually or via the **Warehouse Shipment** or **Inventory Pick**) and can not be changed.

COMPLETE SHIPMENT OF SALES LINE

You can set this field manually if i.e., you do not ship all the **Quantity to be Picked (Base)**, but you will not ship the rest anymore.

This field will also be set automatically to *Yes* in case you have created a **Warehouse Shipment** or **Inventory Pick** that has been handled completely and the **Quantity Picked (Base)** will be the same as the **Quantity to be Picked (Base)**.

LOCATION CODE

The **Location Code** is based on the **Location Code** from the original Sales Line and cannot be changed.

BIN CODE

The **Bin Code** can be filled with the **Bin Code** of the **Sales Line** or the **Bin Code** on which the **Item No.** has a content automatically.

You can change this **Bin Code** manually to a **Bin Code** with content in the **Location Code**.

STATUS

The field **Status** is set automatically by the System but can be changed.

You can choose between the following five options:

Blank	A new Pick Document Line, in which the Quantity Picked (Base) will still be zero.
Planned	When you fill the Bin Code the Status can be set to <i>Planned</i> automatically. When you create a Warehouse Shipment or Inventory Pick the Status can be set to <i>Planned</i> automatically. You can set the Status manually to <i>Planned</i> . I.e., when you handover the Pick Document to a Warehouse Employee so it can be picked, or when the information might be exported to a Handheld Device for scanning.
In Progress	When the Quantity Picked (Base) is filled, the Status will become <i>In Progress</i> automatically. This Status can however also be set manually.

Ready to Post	When you click Post , and only choose <i>Update</i> (so no Posting Shipment or Invoice), the Status will be set automatically to <i>Ready to Post</i> . This Status can however also be set manually. I.e., when you filled the Quantity Picked (Base) and you are transporting the goods to your customer.
Completed	After posting the Pick Document, the Status can be set to <i>Completed</i> automatically. You can set the Status manually to <i>Completed</i> . I.e., when the goods are delivered to the customer.

PICKED QUANTITY UPDATED

The System will set this field to *Yes* automatically *when* you fill the **Quantity Picked (Base)**.

ORDER UPDATED

The System will set this field to *Yes* automatically when you **Update** the Sales Line of the Pick Document Line. This can be done by clicking **Post** or **Post and Print** of the **Pick Document** or **Pick Document per Order** and by choosing *Update*, *Update & Ship* or *Update & Invoice*

POSTED

The System will set this field to *Yes* *when* you **Post** the Pick Document.

This can be done by clicking **Post** or **Post and Print** of the **Pick Document** or **Pick Document per Order** and by choosing *Ship*, *Update & Ship*, *Invoice* or *Update & Invoice*

WAREHOUSE HANDLING TYPE

This will only be visible if **Use Warehouse Functionality** in the Inventory Setup is set to *Yes*.

The System will automatically fill it when you create the Pick Documents: *Blank*, *Whse. Shipment* or *Inv. Pick* depending on the fields in the **Location Code**.

QUANTITY ALLOCATED TO PICK (BASE)

This is a calculated field based on the **Quantity** that has been created on a Warehouse Shipment Line or on an Inventory Pick Line.

INITIATING ORDER NO.

The **Initiating Order No.** is the Sales Order on which the current Pick Document Line is based and cannot be changed.

INITIATING ORDER LINE NO.

The **Initiating Order Line No.** is the Sales Order Line on which the current Pick Document Line is based and cannot be changed.

CONTAINER NO.

The **System will fill the Container No.** when you create an Outbound Container and attach the Sales Lines to it or if you fill the **Container No.** in the Pick Document, FastTab **Delivery**.

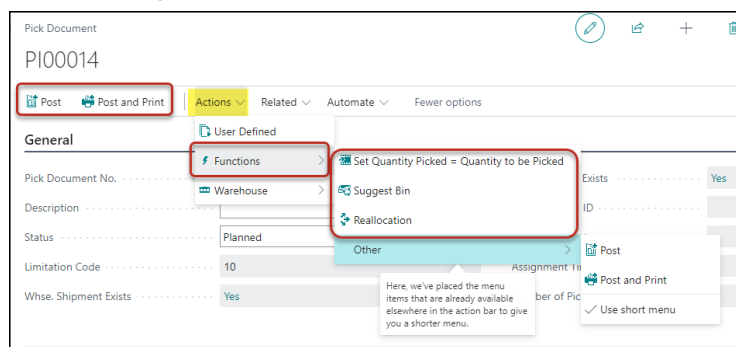

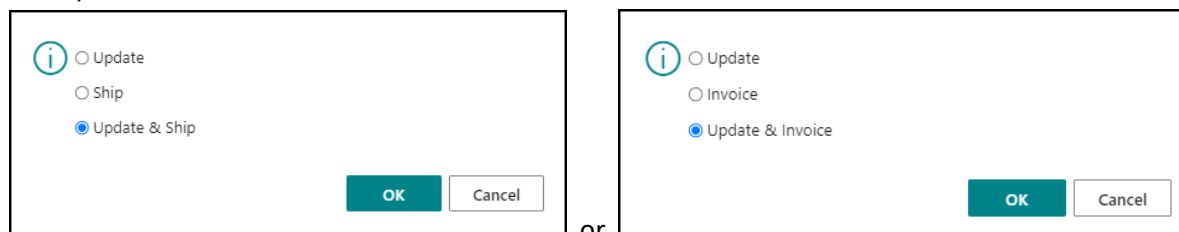
ACTIONS, FUNCTIONS FOR THE PICK DOCUMENT



POST (F9)

All Pick Document Lines will be posted based on the **Quantity Picked (Base)**.

The options:



These options Dialogs will only be shown if the field [Suppress Dialogs at Pick Update & Posting](#) parameter in the Inventory Setup is set to *No*. Which options Dialog will appear, depends on the setting in the [Sales Posting derived from Pick](#) parameter in the Inventory Setup.

You can choose between the following three options if [Sales Posting derived from Pick](#) is *Ship*:

Update	The Qty. to Ship on the Sales Lines is set with the Quantity Picked of the Pick Document Line and the field Order Updated on the Pick Document Line will be set to <i>Yes</i> .
Ship	All Pick Document Lines with the Order Updated field set to <i>Yes</i> , will be posted as a Shipment.
Update & Ship	Both above mentioned actions are carried out

You can choose between the following three options if [Sales Posting derived from Pick](#) is *Ship & Invoice*:

Update	The Qty. to Ship and Qty. to Invoice on the Sales Lines are set with the Quantity Picked of the Pick Document Line and the field Order Updated on the Pick Document Lines will be set to <i>Yes</i> .
Invoice	All Pick Document Lines with the Order Updated field set to <i>Yes</i> , will be posted as a Shipment and as an Invoice.
Update & Ship	Both above mentioned actions are carried out

POST AND PRINT (Shift+F9)

The same as [Post \(F9\)](#) , but now also the Posted Shipment or Posted Invoice will be printed according to the Report Selections Sales to the default windows printer of the user.

NOTE 1

When using these **Post** Actions of the Pick Document, all the Lines of the Pick Document No. will be posted.
If you only want to post the lines of a particular Sales Order within the Pick Document, you can use the Functions of the Action Pane of the Lines: see [Line Action Pane / Functions](#) or Post it via the [Pick Document per Order](#).

NOTE 2

If you post all the Lines of the Pick Document the Pick Document will be deleted.
The Posted Pick Documents however can be found via **Tell me Posted Pick Documents**

NOTE 3

If you post a Pick Document that contains more than 1 Sales Order: per Sales Order a Posted Shipment will be created when you post the Pick Document completely.

NOTE 4

Pick Document Lines will be deleted after posting based on the parameter **Delete Pick by Posting** in the Inventory Setup.

SET QUANTITY PICKED = QUANTITY TO BE PICK

This function will update **Quantity Picked (Base)** on the Pick Document Lines with **Quantity to be Picked (Base)** if the field **Order Updated** is *No*.

After you have executed this Action, the **Status** in the Pick Production Lines will be set to *In Progress* and the **Picked Quantity Updated** will be set to *Yes*.

NOTE

If you want to see the view of Pick Document per Order List: Do not post the Pick Document at this point.
If you also want to see the **Reallocation** for the Sales Orders on your Pick Document: Do not post the Pick Document at this point.
Or make a backup of your company; so, you can use this situation again.

SUGGEST BIN

This action is only applicable if **Use Warehouse Functionality** in the Inventory Setup is set to *No*, and you use a simple setup for the Bin Codes.

It can fill the **Bin Code** on the Pick Document Lines, based on the Bin Content by Bin Ranking that was created while posting a Receipt of a Purchase Order or Finishing a Production Order.

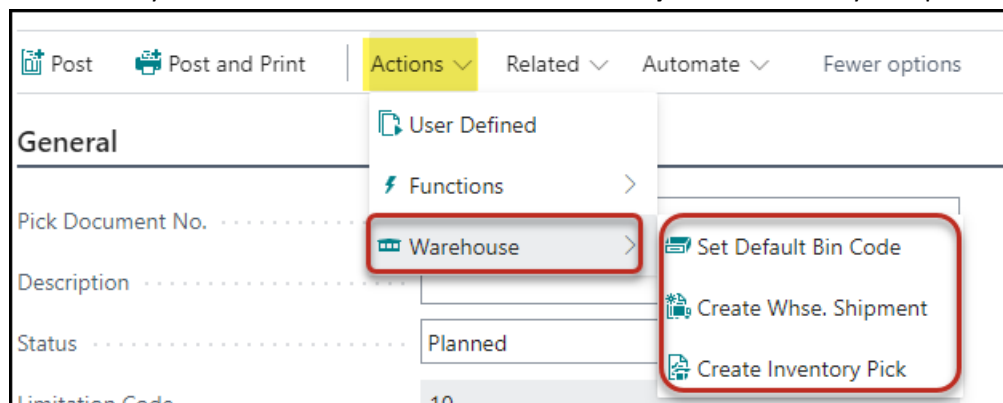

SET DEFAULT BIN CODE

If the field **Bin Mandatory** in the **Location Code** is set to Yes, and the field **Directed Put-Away and Pick** in the **Location Code** is set to No, this action can fill the **Bin Code** on the Pick Document Lines with the **Default Bin Code** for the Item that can be set while posting a Receipt of a Purchase Order or Finishing a Production Order.

CREATE WHSE. SHIPMENT

If the field **Warehouse Handling Type** is *Whse. Shipment* – which was set while creating the Pick Document Lines based on the fields in the **Location Code**, this action can create a **Warehouse Shipment** with Pick Document Lines of this Pick Document.

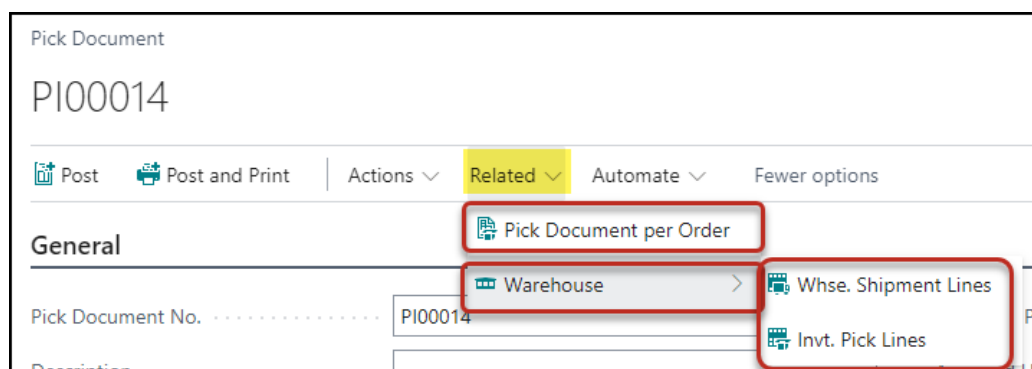

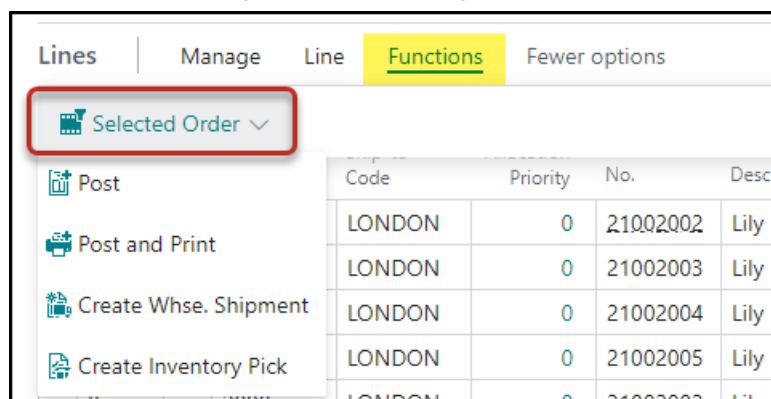

SELECTED ORDER, POST

All Pick Document Lines with the same Sales Order (**Initiating Order No.**) as the Line that you are standing on and within the same Pick Document No. will be posted.

SELECTED ORDER, POST AND PRINT

Keep in mind that deletion of a Pick Document depends on the field **Delete Pick by Posting** in the Inventory Setup. CREATE WHSE. SHIPMENT

NOTE

In this White Paper, we will not describe the standard Business Central WMS functionality, like the total handling of the Warehouse Shipments / Picks or Inventory Picks, because this functionality has not been changed besides showing Matrix Lines, or some extra fields regarding a Pick Document No. or a Container No. to express where a Line is coming from.

If you want to use the Reallocation function, the **Quantity Picked** must be Zero. Otherwise, you cannot change the **Quantity to Pick** in the Reallocation Matrix.

If you have a Master with Colors, Lengths, Fabric and Sizes, the **No.** represents the Master+Color+Length+Fabric. The number of Orders and the quantities are also calculated for that level.

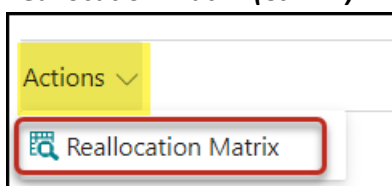

If you had pressed **CTRL+M** on a **Y-Axis** line, you only would have seen the lines within one Y-Axis (in this case, only one Color, i.e., *Black*).

The quantities in the brackets besides the Sizes - i.e., XS [0] - represent the available Inventory of the Sizes for the Line (Color) that the cursor is on. In the previous Picture, it is for the color *White*.

Changing the quantities in the cells, will directly have its influence on the quantities between brackets besides the Sizes. Therefore, you will have a clear overview of the quantity that still can be assigned to another Pick Document Line. You might however need to press **F5** Refresh.
