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INTRODUCTION

TRIMIT has a possibility of choosing different languages on Portals. All the translations per language are stored in Portals macro files.

This document goes through management of the macro files for the following TRIMIT portals: *Sales Agent, Business to Business, Supplier and B2S Shop.*

MACRO FILES LOCATION

Macro files can be placed in two places in portals installation folder. By default the translation file can be found in **C:\CPO\CpoAdmin\Resources\Macros**.

As soon as modifications are made to the translation file - then all changed translations are placed in a new separate macro file which is placed in a following default location:

C:\CPO\CustomPrivate\Macros.

This is a screenshot of a customized macro translation file:

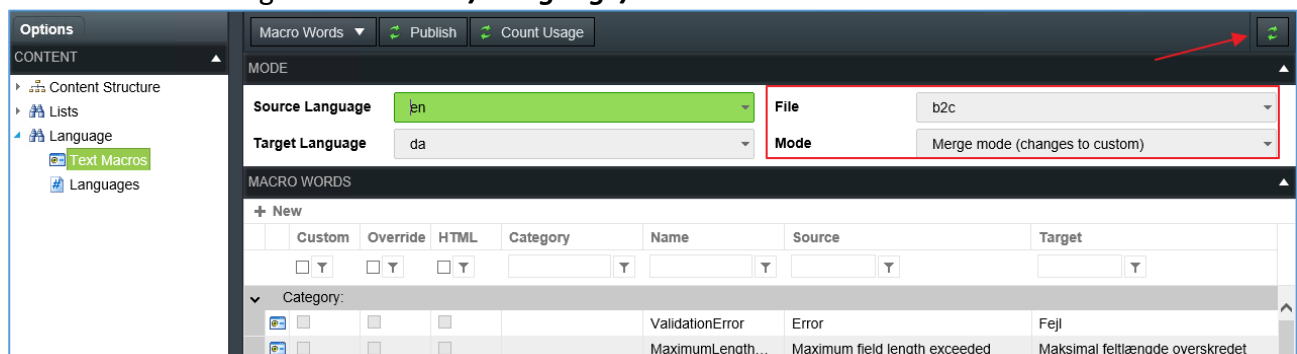

TRANSLATION MANAGEMENT IN CPO ADMIN

Translation file can be modified directly in folders specified above. But the CPO admin has a functionality to do this task, which is called Text Macros. To open Text Macros - log in to the CPO admin site and navigate to **Content / Language/ Text Macros**.

NOTE: to see needed translations in Macro Words section - it might be needed to change values in File and Mode fields and refresh the results as shown above.

DESCRIPTION OF THE CONTROLS IN MODE

Source language

Choose a source language from the activated in the ConnectPortal

Target language

Choose a target language from the activated in the ConnectPortal

File

Choose specific macro file

Mode

Allows choosing specific folder, i.e. CpoAdmin, CustomPrivate or a mix of both. Available options are: **System** (macro file in CpoAdmin folder), **Custom** (macro file in CustomPrivate folder) and **"Merge mode (changes to custom)"**.

DESCRIPTION OF THE CONTROLS IN MACRO WORDS

New

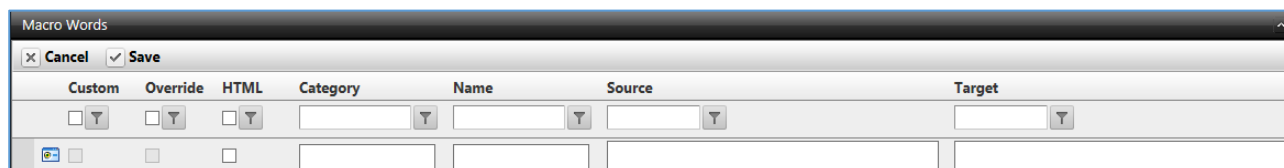
Use this control to create a new translation in the current file. Before pressing on **New** - set **Source** and **Target languages**, choose **File** where new translation text has to be created.

Modifications of the existing translations as well as new translations will be placed in a copy of the main macro file within CustomPrivate folder.

The main macro file for *Sales Agent*, *Business to Business* and *Supplier* portals is called **portals**, whereas for the *B2C shop* it is called **b2c**.

After pressing on **New** control - new buttons **Cancel** and **Save** will be displayed instead of **New** button.



Insert the necessary data and press on **Save**. Press **Cancel** to skip the insertion.

Custom

Indicates whether the translation is default (*False*) or created by customer (*True*). It is set automatically and can be used for filtering

Override

Allows filtering on data overwritten in a custom file

HTML

On create a new translation set a check mark in this field in order to indicate that this translation text holds HTML markup. Then it is possible to filter on this field.

Category

Translation text sub category, used for filtering purposes

Name

Name of the translation in a macro file by which it can be found by the CPO. This name has to be unique within the file

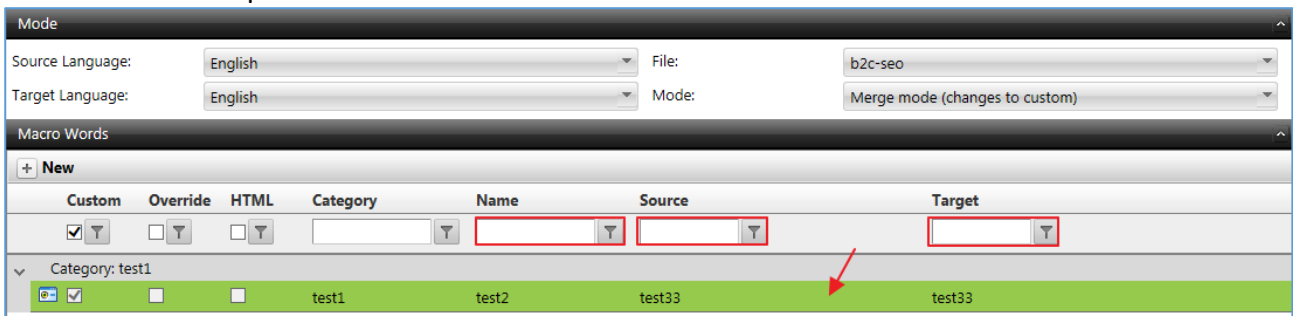
Source

Translation text of the source language

Target

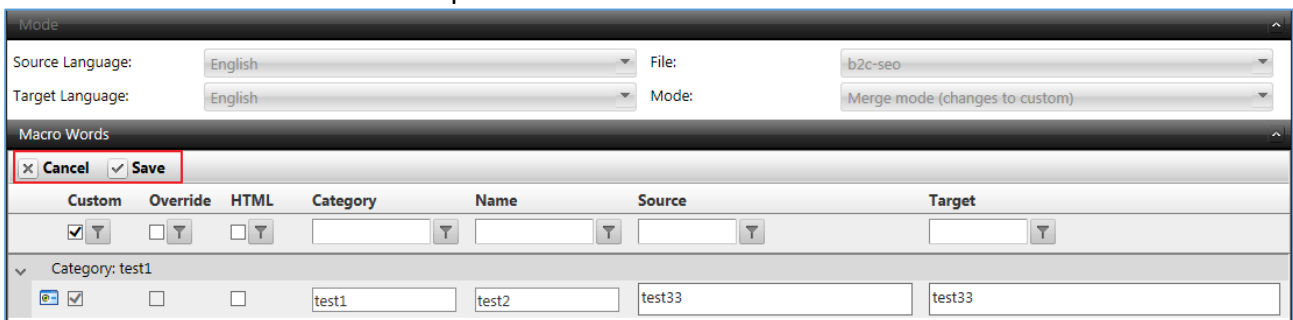
Translation text of the target language

To modify the translation it is needed to choose corresponding **Source** and **Target languages**, then choose needed **Mode** and **File**. Then filter on needed **Name**, **Source** or **Target** by typing key words in those fields and press Enter afterwards.



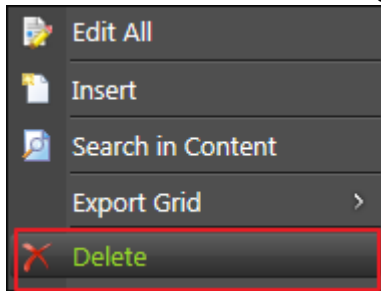

If translation exists – double click on the line and after this the translation will be displayed in edit mode. After corrections are made press on **Save** or **Cancel**.

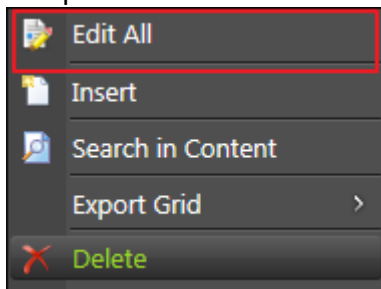

To delete the translation – right click on translation line and choose **Delete** in menu:



In order to enable editing all the translations in a current file – click on the translation line and choose **Edit All** in menu. All the translation lines will be displayed in editing mode. After editing is complete click on **Save** or **Cancel**.



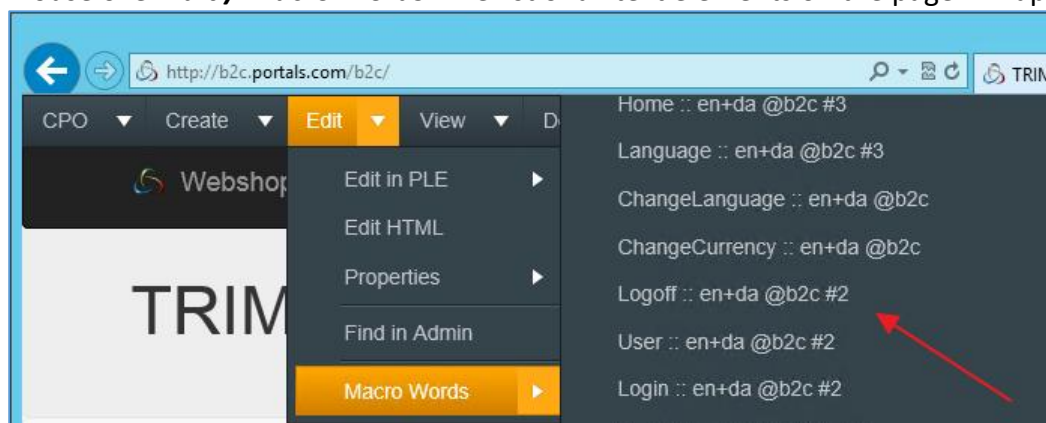
Option **Insert** in the menu equals to creating a new translation text line.

Option **Search in Content** is one of the searching options.

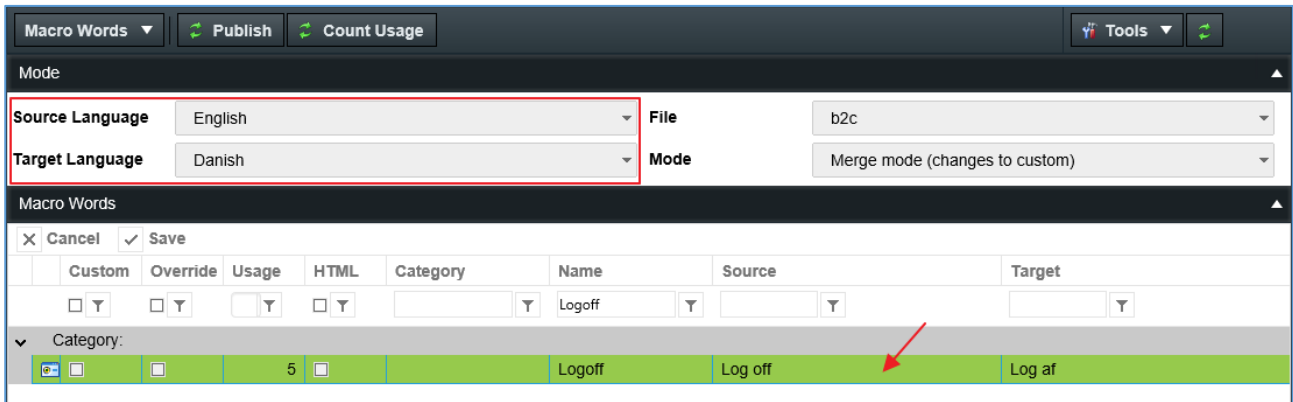
Option **Export Grid** allows exporting the view into different formats, like DPF, Excel, Word and csv.

TRANSLATION MANAGEMENT ON PORTAL

It is possible to address specific translations from the Portals pages with no need to go to CPO administration part. Using administrative credentials open Portals. In Admin helper menu hover mouse over **Edit / Macro Words**. The list of all text elements on the page will appear.



Clicking on specific text element will open the Macro Words:

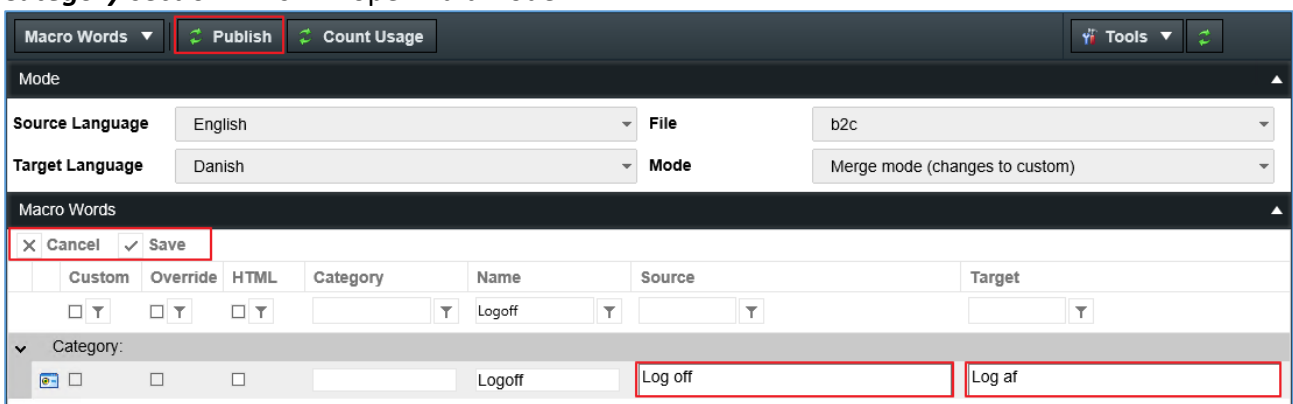
