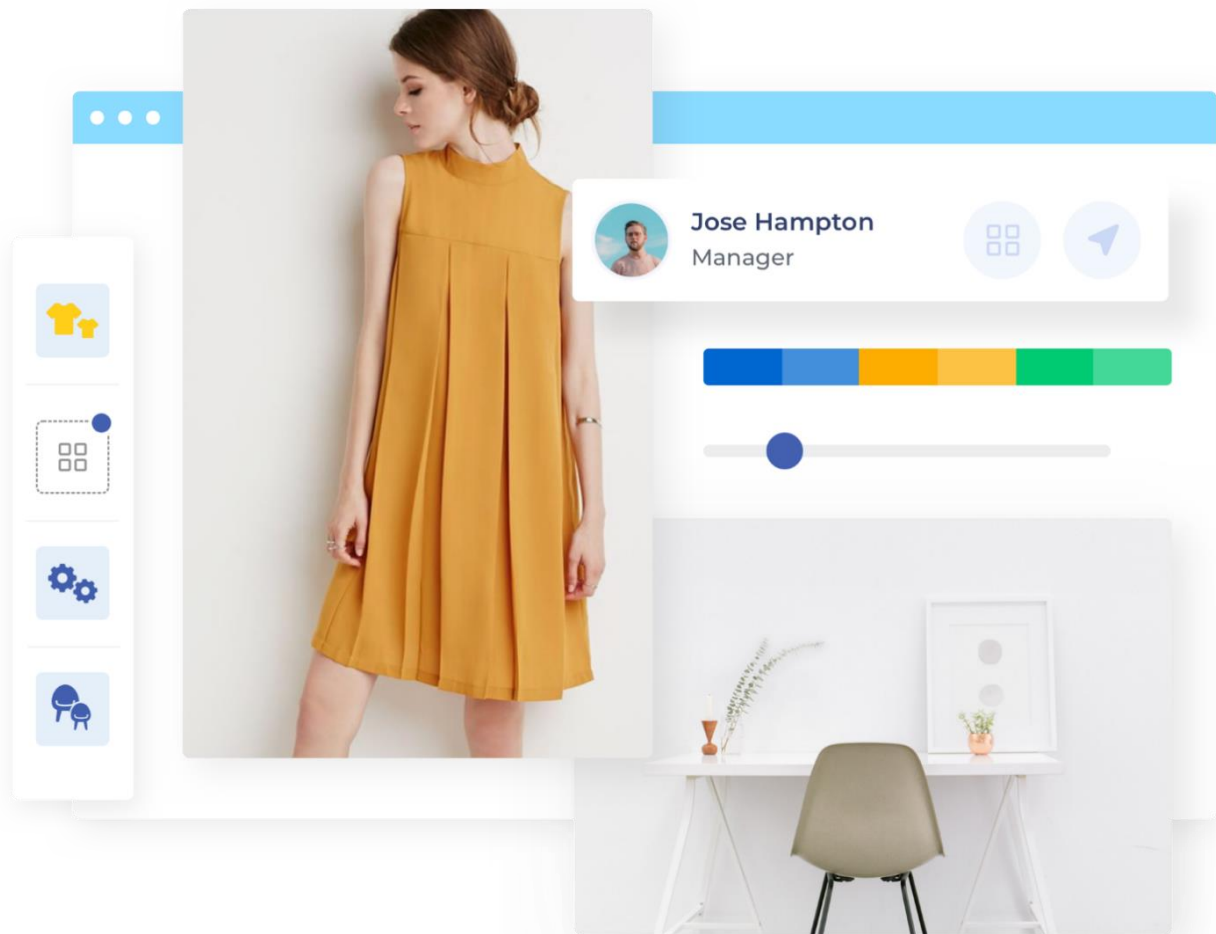




WHITE PAPER

NON-SELLABLE PRODUCTS ON B2C

This document contains information about the setting of non-sellable products functionality in TRIMIT for Business Central BC13 R2.

Date: 01-01-2020

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INTRODUCTION

Enabling non-sellable product functionality allows the entire B2C webshop or specific product collections or only a specific product, to work in a view only mode, where it is not possible to navigate to basket, log in, register. As well as displaying product quantity, adding to basket, showing “sold out” messages and hiding the availability links on the product page. Only the VarDim types like color and size will be visible on the product page. This can be used in brand stores and showrooms.

The functionality described is the functionality in **TRIMIT for Business Central BC13 R2**.

The pictures in this White Paper are based on the demo database for **TRIMIT Business Central W1 BC13 R2**, which is based on Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central on premises 2019 release wave 2 (October release), in the demo company **CRONUS TRIMIT W1 Ltd.** (based on CRONUS International Ltd. of Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central).

ERP SETUP

This chapter contains information about the Setups that you need to enable non sellable products on TRIMIT B2C webshop.

PORTAL PROFILE SETUP

B2C portal profile has a field **No Sale**. If this field is set to *TRUE*, then these B2C webshop elements will be hidden for all the products on the B2C webshop:

- Cart icon, Register and Log in in top menu
- Quantity, add to cart button, sold out text and not in stock link on the product page
- Availability link at the bottom on the product page

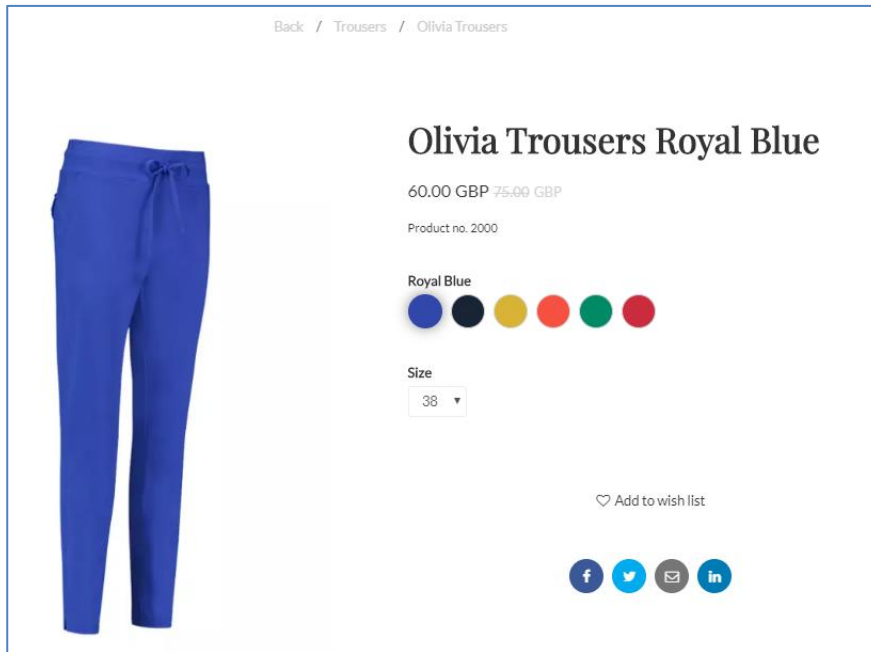

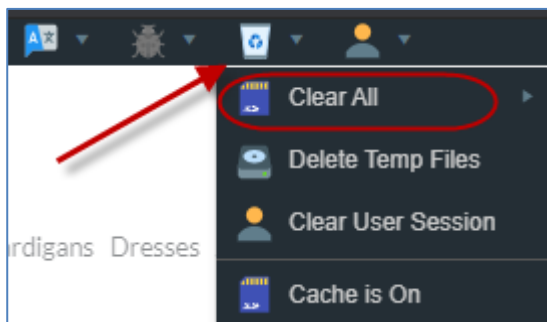

The view on B2C product page when **No Sales** in set to *TRUE*:



The change is reflected after clearing the server cache on the B2C webshop (requires admin login).



CATEGORY SETUP

Alternatively, an individual product can be set to non-sellable. This can be set up in the category structure and more specifically on the category lines. **Category Lines** page has a field **Sales Status**. This field has the following options: *Sellable* and *Show Only*. If set to *Sellable* then the product will become sellable on B2C webshop (this includes showing availability). If set to *Show Only*, then it will only be possible to show the product, but not add to basket. The default value is *Sellable*.

If *Show Only* is set for individual products, then Availability link will be shown on product page to show the stores where the product is available.

It is also possible to set *Show Only* for a collection on category lines. In this case all the collection related masters will become non sellable and adding those products to basket will not be possible. The change on category lines will require running Update Shop in B2C soft admin.

NOTE:

(non-sell warning on product details page): when non-sell is set on category lines then warning is only shown on non-sell masters. If non-sell set globally on profile, then warning is removed from product details page for all master even those which are manually set to non-sell.
