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Introduction

This White Paper describes the functionality of the **TRIMIT PDM Report Set**.

This functionality enables users to set up the fields they want to see in the header of our PDM Reports. It also enables users to set up a Report Set containing several PDM Reports that should be shown, sent by E-Mail, or shown in pdf-files at once, based on a specific chosen **Output to**.

It is still possible to print the individual PDM Reports.

But if you use the report called **Master Reports** it can only be handled by using the **PDM Report Set**.

It is also possible to send the pdf-file of the PDM Reports to the Vendor of a Master by using the **TRIMIT E-Mail Templates**. For more details see **White Paper – TRIMIT E-Mail**.

Note

In the rest of the White Paper, we will simply talk about *print(ed)* when referring to the output of the PDM Report Sets.

The audience for this document is the Consultant or very skilled User. It will only describe the TRIMIT fields/functionality and not the standard Business Central fields/functionality. Be aware of not changing settings and parameters in a live database without consulting the implementing partner.

The functionality described is the functionality as of **TRIMIT 25.2 for Business Central W1 BC27.X**.

The pictures in this White Paper are based on the demo data for **TRIMIT 25.2**, which is based on Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central 2025 Release Wave 2, in the demo company **CRONUS TRIMIT W1 Ltd.** (based on CRONUS International Ltd. of Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central).

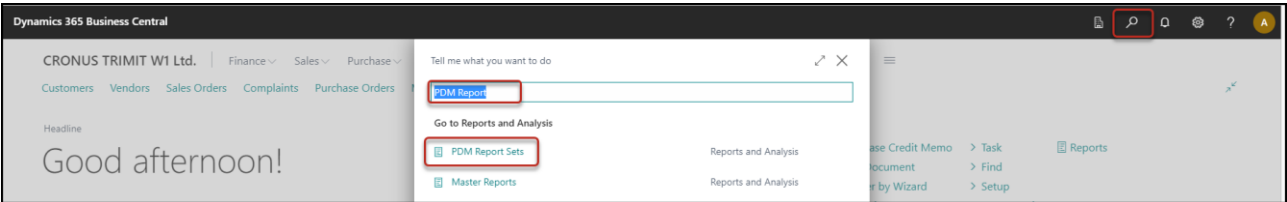

PDM Report Set

You can set up several **PDM Report Sets** to combine different PDM Reports that need to be shown on your screen, to be sent to a Vendor as pdf-file or to download as pdf-file, so you can print it afterwards. It is also possible to determine which fields should be shown in the header of the reports:

This is the unique key for the Table **6037230 trm PDM Report Set**.

Description

You can enter a **Description** for this PDM Report Set

Default

You can set up the fields you want to see in the Header of the PDM Reports. This can be done for every PDM Report Set individually, and even per Report in the Report Set.
A checkmark in the field **Default** sets the defaults for these fields.
That means that if a PDM Report Set might not have the fields filled for the Header of the Reports, the settings of this specific PDM Report Set will be used.
You can only have 2 (one) PDM Report Set with a checkmark in **Default**.

Print Language

You can enter the **Language** to print the names of the fields in the header of the PDM Reports.
This will however depend on the settings in the specific PDM Report Set regarding the fields you want to print, and the Language related captions you have entered for these fields.

Per **PDM Report Set** you can set up maximum 10 fields you want to see in the header of the PDM Reports.

File Name

This field is not by default on the page; you need to add it via **Personalize**.
When printing the **Master Reports**, the output can be a pdf-file, and with the field **File Name** you can determine the name of that pdf-file.
You can choose between the following three options:

Master_[No.][Description]	This could result in Master_2000_Olivia Trousers.pdf
[No.][Description]	This could result in 2000_Olivia Trousers.pdf
[No.]	This could result in 2000.pdf

The default is the *Master_[No.][Description]*.

For every **PDM Report Set**, you can set up the fields and content of the fields that need to be printed in the header of the PDM Reports.

Header

You can choose the **Header** for the report.

You can choose between the following five options:

Default	Depends on the PDM Report Set that is set as the Default
Report Name	The name of the actual Report
Master No. and Description	The Code of the Master and the Description
Master Description	Only the Master Description
Text	You can enter a Text yourself in the next field Header Text

Header Text

Here you can enter a **Header Text** that will be printed as the title of the Report if you choose the last option for **Header**: *Text*.

Note

If **Header** is not filled with *Text*, the **Header Text** will not be printed.

Line 1 – Line 10

Here you can determine from which field of the Master; the content should be printed on the corresponding Line in the Header of the PDM Report.

You can choose between the following twenty-two options:

From the field you selected in **Line 1 – Line 10** you can determine what content should be printed.
You can choose between the following three options:

Description	Only the Description/Name of the content from the selected field.
Code and Description	The Code and the Description/Name of the content from the selected field.
Code	Only the Code of the content from the selected field.

I.e.:

If you choose **Item Statistics Group 2** and you choose **Description** you will see: *Coats*
If you choose **Item Statistics Group 2** and you choose **Code and Description** you will see: *150 Coats*
If you choose **Item Statistics Group 2** and you choose **Code**, you will see: *150*

Caption Line 1 – Caption Line 10

You can determine according to the **Language Code** what the **Caption** should be that should be printed.

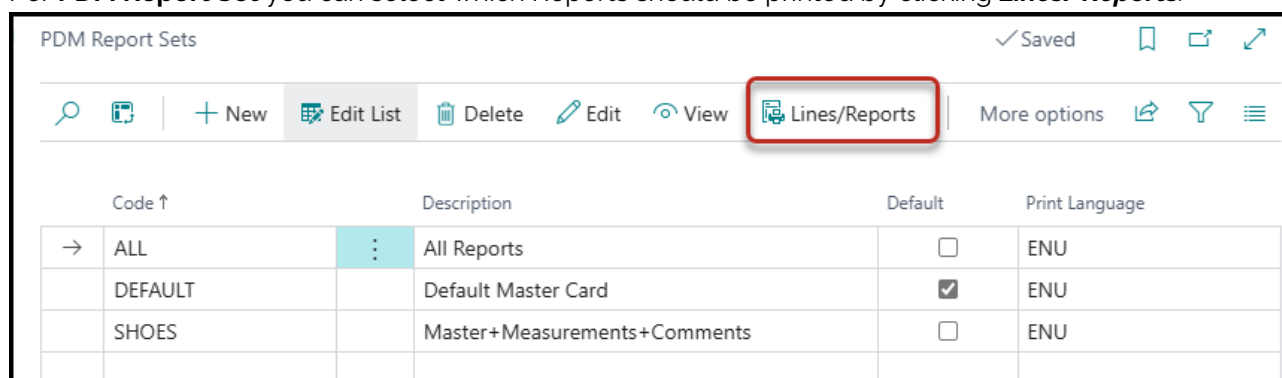
You do not have to fill in these Line/Show/Caption Line fields for every PDM Report Set. You can fill them for one PDM Report Set that has a checkmark in the field **Default** and in the other PDM Report Sets, you can leave all the **Line 1 – 10** set to *Default* and all the **Show 1 – 10** fields set to *Description*. In that case, the settings of the **Default** PDM Report Set will be taken.

Keep in mind however, that if you might change the content of the fields **Line 1 – 10** you also need to change the **Caption Lines** again.

If you leave the Caption Lines blank, the system will take the regular names of the fields, and for the fields for which you can enter the Captions via the **Caption Class Setup** it will take these Captions.

PDM Report Set Lines

Per **PDM Report Set** you can select which Reports should be printed by clicking **Lines/Reports**.

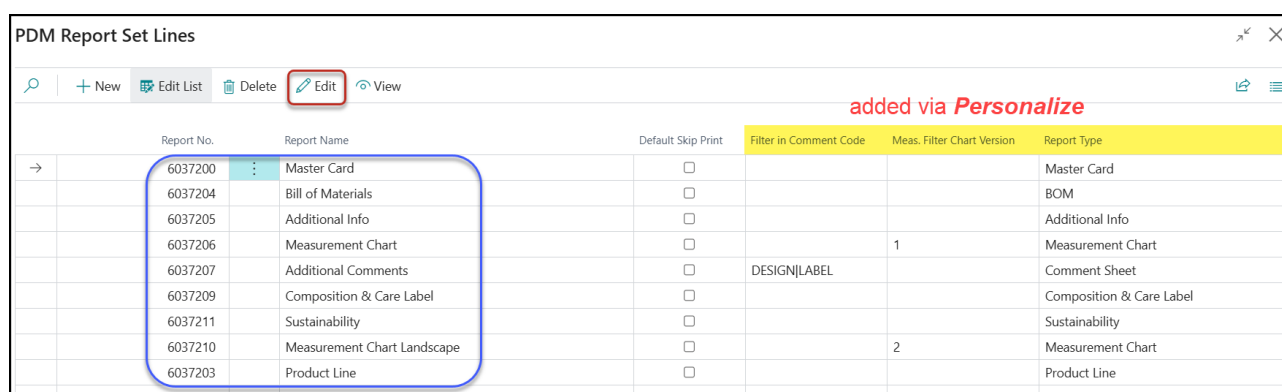

Report No.

You can select **Report No.** via **Look up value**.

The **Report Name** will be displayed.

The **Report Nos.** shown in the picture above are the only reports that – by default – are available for the **PDM Report Set Lines**.

If you want to include other reports as well – with a Main Table of *6037103 Master* – you need to adjust them, so they can be included in a **PDM Report Set Lines** with **Report Type User Defined**.

Default Skip Print

By default, you can set the **Report No.** to be skipped when printing the **Master Reports** which use this **PDM Report Set**. During the print, you are still able to select/unselect a specific **Report No.**

Filter in Comment Code

For the Report of the **Report Type** *Comment Sheet*, you can select specific **Filter in Comment Code** to include only specific Codes of the Additional Comments.

Meas. Filter Chart Version

For the Report of the **Report Type** *Measurement Chart*, you can select specific **Meas. Filter Chart Version** to include only specific Versions of the Measurement Chart.

Note

There are two reports regarding the **Measurement Chart**:
The **6037206 Measurement Chart** which will print the report of the Measurement Chart in Portrait format.
The **6037210 Measurement Chart Landscape** which will print the report of the Measurement Chart in Landscape format.
You should pick one of the two reports and not both if you want to have the Measurement Chart as part of the total report set for the PDM Reports.

For these PDM Reports, you can set up the details regarding the **Report Options** you want to use, when this specific PDM Report is printed.
Therefore, you need to click **Edit**.

What is Printed/Exported exactly

As you have seen in the previous chapters you can set up:

1. Fields that default need to be printed in the header of all the PDM Report Lines (individual PDM Reports) of all the PDM Report Sets (if **Default** is Yes of a PDM Report Set)
2. Fields that need to be printed in the header of all the PDM Report Lines (individual PDM Reports) on a specific PDM Report Set
3. Fields that need to be printed in the header of a specific PDM Report Line (individual PDM Report) of a PDM Report Set

Setup of 3. is the highest priority. However, if the field is set to *Default* the settings of 1. will be taken. If there is no setup for 3. the setup of 2. will be taken, but if the field is set to *Default* the settings of 1. will be taken.

The specific **Header Fields** are only applicable for the following Reports based on the **Report Type**:

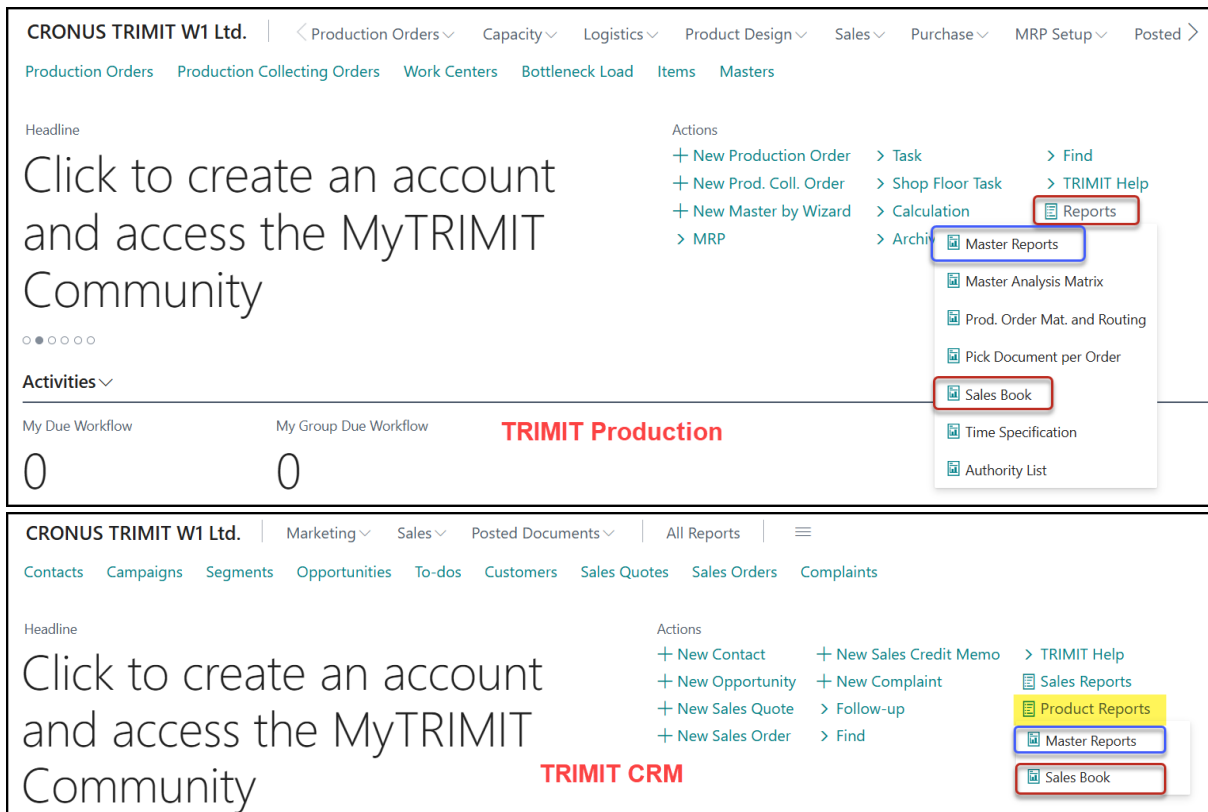

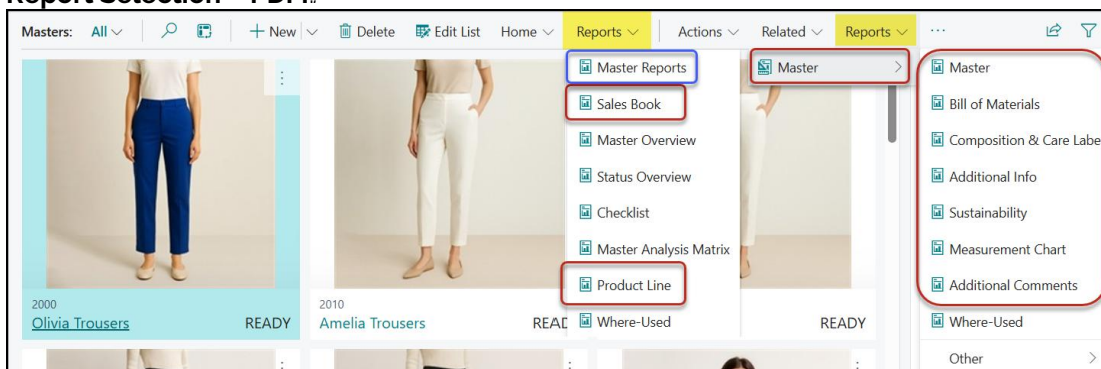

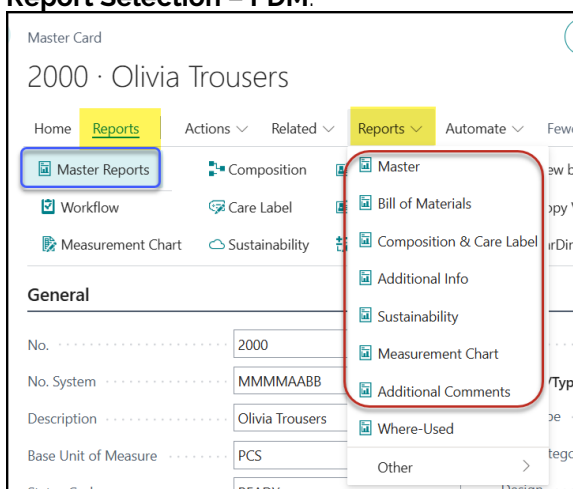
