TRIMIT Table Information Editor 23.1

This document contains information about the Table Information Editor functionality in TRIMIT 23.1 for Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central 2023, Wave 1 (W1).

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INTRODUCTION

We have created a special **Table Information Editor**, in which you are able to see the content of a Table but are also able to replace the content of a specific Field in a Table.

When using the regular BC Table Information, it always takes some time before the list is showing all the Tables and the number of records.

With the **Table Information Editor**, you can see the content very quickly for one specific Table and are even able to change the content of the Tables.

The audience for this document is the Consultant or very skilled User.

It will only describe the TRIMIT fields/functionality and not the standard Business Central fields/functionality.

Be aware of not changing settings and parameters in a live database without consulting the implementing partner.

NOTE

The **Replace** function in the **Table Information Editor** should not be used lightly; users need to know what the consequences are if they might change content of Fields in a Table – and replacing Fields that are part of the Primary Key of the **Table No.** is not possible.

The **Replace** function should NEVER be used while using a Development License.

The functionality described is the functionality as of **TRIMIT 23.1 for Business Central W1 BC22.X**.

The pictures in this White Paper are based on the demo database for **TRIMIT 23.1**, which is based on Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central 2023 Release Wave 1, in the demo company **CRONUS TRIMIT W1 Ltd.** (based on CRONUS International Ltd. of Microsoft Dynamics 365 Business Central).

COMPONENTS

TRIMIT Table Information Editor contains the following objects:

The tables **6036581 trm Table Editor**

The pages **6036580 trm Table Information Editor**
 6036582 trm Table Info With Caption
 6036583 trm Table Info Editor Value

The permission set **TRM-TABLE EDITOR** with RIMD rights for Table **6036581 trm Table Editor**

Besides these specific objects, many other Tables are affected, when you want to change the content. In that case, the user needs to have the correct Permissions for those Tables.

TABLE INFORMATION EDITOR

The page for the **Table Information Editor** can be found via **Search Table Information Editor**.

FASTTAB SEARCH

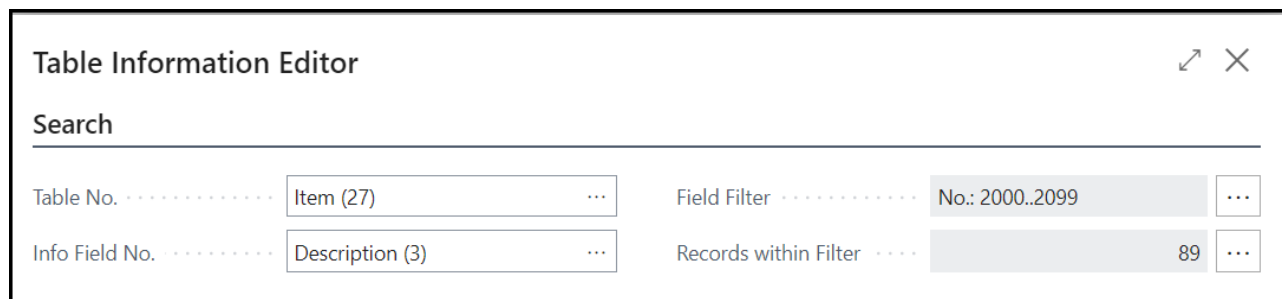


TABLE NO.

In **Table No.** you can enter the Number of the Table for which you want to view the records, or for which you want to change the content.

The name of the **Table No.** will automatically be shown.

When using the lookup or entering a **Table No.** the system will check if the user has “Read” and/or “Modify” Rights for this Table, otherwise the user can not choose this **Table No.**

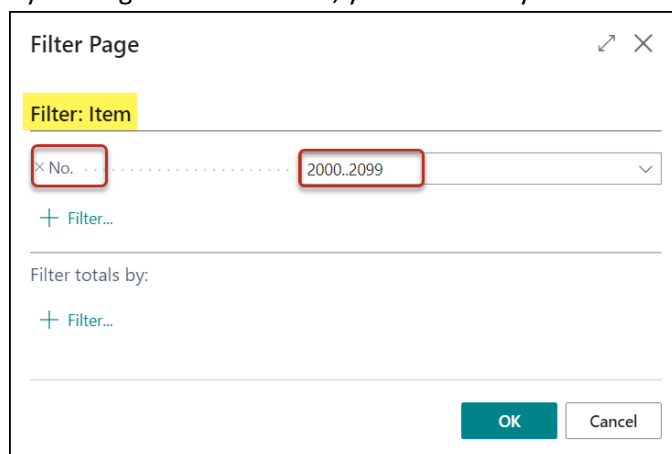
INFO FIELD NO.

In **Info Field No.** you can select the Field of **Table No.** you want to see as the info of the Field in the list of Records in which a Field could be replaced.

FIELD FILTER

In **Field Filter** you can set the Filters for the Records you want to see or for which you want to replace the content.

By clicking Assist-Button , you can set any Filter on the **Table No.** I.e.:



ENTRIES WITHIN FILTER

In **Entries within Filter**, you can see the number of records in **Table No.** based on the **Field Filter**.

When clicking on the Assist-Button , you will see those records. I.e., the Item List

FASTTAB REPLACE

If you now only want to see the content of a **Table No.**, but also want to replace content in a **Table No.**, you need to fill fields in the FastTab **Replace**.

Users can only **Replace** content of Fields if they also have “Modify” Rights for the chosen **Table No.**

Users can only use the **Replace** if they also have Read, Create, Modify and Delete Rights for Table **6036581 trm Table Info Editor**.

FIELD NO.

You can choose the **Field No.** of the **Table No.** for which you want to change the content.

SEARCH

Depending on the **Field No.** you can choose the following three options – but this is only possible if the **Field No. Type** is *Text* or *OemText*:

Whole Field	The Find What must be the content of the whole Field No. This is the default value if the Type or the Field No. is not <i>Text</i> or <i>OemText</i> .
Beginning of Field	The Find What must be the content at the beginning of the Field No.
Any Part of Field	The Find What must be anywhere in the text of the Field No.

MATCH SEARCH

A checkmark in this field, means that the **Find What** must apply in the same lower-/upper case.

FIND WHAT

In this field, you can enter the content of the **Field No.** that should be found and replaced, based on the **Search**.

REPLACE WITH

In this field, you can enter the content that should replace the **Find What**.

REPLACE WHOLE FIELD

A checkmark in this field, means that the total content of the **Field No.** will be replaced with the **Replace With**.

REPLACE FROM RELATED RECORD

A checkmark in this field will open the FastTab **Replace Value from Related Record**.

FASTTAB REPLACE VALUE FROM RELATED RECORD

This FastTab will only become visible if **Replace from Related Record** is set to Yes.

Instead of using the **Find What** and **Replace With**, you can also determine that a specific **Field No.** should be filled with the content of a **Related Value Field No.** from a **Related Value Table No.**

In the **Related Link Field No.**, you choose the field of the **Table No.** that has a relation with the **Related Value Table No.**

I.e., you want to fill the **Salesperson** in the Sales Header with the **Salesperson** of the **Bill-to Customer** of the Sales Header, because the Salesperson has changed for this **Bill-to Customer** from *JR* to *CE*.

After you have filled the necessary fields, you need to click the **OK button**.

Based on the filtered records from the **Table No.** and the **Find What/Replace With** or the **Replace Value from Related Record** fields, the system will determine for which records of the **Table No.** a change might be applicable and show those records in a page.

Only if the current value and the new value differ the records from **Table No.** will be shown.

SOME EXAMPLES

I.e., for replacing the **Vendor Item No.** in the Item:

This list will show the records with the **Current** Field Name (i.e., Vendor Item No.) based on the **Find What** and the **New** Field Name (i.e., Vendor Item No.) based on the **Replace With**.

It will only show the records for which there is a difference between the **Current** and the **New**.

You can select the **RecordID Text** Lines that you want to Replace and then click **Replace Selected**, or you can determine to **Replace All**.

After you clicked **Replace Selected** or **Replace All** you will get a message and the content is replaced:

This list will show the records with the **Current** Field Name (i.e., Salesperson Code) based on the **Field No.** and the **New** Field Name (i.e., Salesperson Code) based on the **Related Value Field No.**

It will only show the records for which there is a difference between the **Current** and the **New**.

You can select the **RecordID Text** Lines that you want to Replace and then click **Replace Selected**, or you can determine to **Replace All**.

After you clicked **Replace Selected** or **Replace All** you will get a message and the content is replaced:
